## How the WebEX Training System works:

WebEX training sessions are limited to 100 people.

Step 1 - Click the new WebEX page on the NS Web Site at: <u>www.uscgaan.com</u>.

Step 2 - Access this training session by clicking on the RED link, "First Tuesday of the
