Program Objectives

- To provide a means to ensure that all of the Harbormaster System's documentation for private aids to navigation is accurate and that private aids are watching properly early in the boating season.
- Develop a quick and reliable face-to-face means to correct any issues on a private aid record in the Harbormaster System and on any related Federal documentation such as the LNM, the Light List and the NOAA chart..
 - With miniminal paperwork, and
 - Providing early correction benefits to the mariners.
- Develop a one-on-one relationship and dialog between the Coast Guard and local Harbormasters concerning their private aid to navigation program.
 - Resolve problems on scene rather than by multiple e-mails and reports

TRI-ANNUAL VERIFICATION OF ALL PRIVATE AIDS TO NAVIGATION

- The <u>CG First District Commander</u> has directed that every private aid to navigation be verified and reported once every <u>three</u> years.
- USCG Auxiliarists are trained and qualified as Aid Verifiers
 (AV's) before they are allowed to perform a verification.
- Each AV works for the local CG Aids to Navigation Team (ANT) when performing these verifications.
- Each private aid that is scheduled for Tri-Annual verification or that is observed with a discrepancy must be reported on-line on the CG Harbormaster PATON System.
- The Harbormaster or Owner of record will receive a copy of this report CG 7054 PATON Report.

The Process

- The Harbormaster provides the platform for observing their permitted private aids.
- The Coast Guard provides a trained representative (Aid Verifier) to perform the verifications with the Harbormaster.
- The AV provides the skills, the positioning equipment and data collection forms to accurately and quickly verify or check each Private Aid with the Harbormaster.
- The AV works with the Coast Guard to review the observations and to process the Tri-annual CG 7054 PATON Reports into the PATON's digital record.

These aids are scheduled for a Tri-Annual Verification in 2017. A CG5074 PATON Report must be submitted.

STANDARD FOLLOW UP PROCESS

- <u>Lateral</u> private aid discrepancies (any Private Aid with a LLNR) are reported in the <u>Local Notice to Mariners</u> (LNM).
- Position changes and other major corrections that are listed in the LNM may become chart corrections by NOAA. NOAA makes the charting decision.
- Note that every Private Aids may not be listed in the Light List.
- Also note that some Private Aids listed in the Light List are not always charted.

Annual Wrap Up

- The Harbormaster will receive a copy of the updated Run worksheet showing the results of the Run.
- All required <u>Tri-annual CG7054 Reports</u> for the record will show the Harbormaster's Private Aids as watching properly.
 - No further follow up is required.
 - A digital record is established on the Harbormaster System.
- The Harbormaster is assured that all of their aids will be documented correctly per the Run Sheet.
- All related documents (<u>LNM</u>, <u>Light List</u> and <u>NOAA Chart</u>) will be updated by the Coast Guard to reflect the positions and specifications shown on the Run Sheet.
