Call to Order - Meeting called to order by FC Sedgwick at 1913 H.

Pledge of Allegiance - Pledge led FC Sedgwick.

Introduction of Guests - None.

Approval of Minutes - Call by VFC Peda for motion to approve April, 2016 Meeting Minutes, seconded by FC Sedgwick. Motion passed unanimously.

Elected Officer Reports -

-FC Sedgwick - 40% of all Division 5 Members have completed the new Mandatory Training requirement. 42% of Flotilla 05-10 Members are certified in AUXMT. Though these levels are about average nationally, some Flotillas have done much better. The Auxiliary MT requirements take some time, but are not unreasonable: the goal of both National and Division 5 is 90% completion, by the end of 2016. Thus the team-work to reach AUXMT completion continues, from sessions after Meetings to Member outreach; we are coordinating efforts with the other four Flotillas OF Division 5.

-Each Member must also update their Skills Bank, Form 7028 (link located in Member profiles of AUXOFFICER): Sector or National may need certain personnel, and they turn to that Skills Bank.

-Boat Crew update: three 05-10 Members are qualified and up-to-date with Boat Crew, and three additional are in training. Both BC training and PPE requirements are more stringent and professional than even just a few years ago: we are a better force.

-Three Members are training to be Vessel Examiners, a core Auxiliary mission.

-Fleet Week 2016 - Contact IPDCAPT Porter; an e-mail for signing up has been sent out. Several Members have stated that they will assist with either the USCG Cutter to be docked at the USS Intrepid pier, or with the PA tent dockside.

-VFC Peda - Operations update: three radios have been secured, and are available for missions.
