

We may be facing an event of epic proportions. Our primary concern is safety and accountability of our members. Beginning Thursday, 13 September, we will adopt the following until further notice:

1. Flotillas will establish and maintain 100% accountability. Accountability information/numbers will be reported through the CoL/M: Flotilla Commanders to Division Commanders to District Captains. The DCAPTs will review, prepare and forward their sector report to CDR May and DCO Adams. (DCDRs - your reports will be submitted to your DCAPT daily NLT than 1000 and a with a second report at 2000.) In addition to member accountability information, reportable items should include an overview and assessment of the situation in your division's AOR. The DCAPTs will include a summary of these reportable items as well as accountability data in their 1000 and 2000 reports.
2. Administrative concerns/messages are suspended until further notice. This includes forwarding of approved meeting minutes and approved financial reports as well as various Auxiliary administrative forms such as Change of Officers, Disenrollment, etc.
3. No member will self activate or self deploy. For coordination, any requests for active duty support, i.e., activation or deployment, at any Coast Guard unit or cutter are to be routed through CDR May and DCO Adams.
4. Maximum documentation to include photography of Auxiliary operations is encouraged. We will coordinate collection through the DSO-PA after the storm/recovery.
5. Given past experience with similar weather-related events, communications via cell phone audio and text messages may well become the norm. While electrical outages are anticipated, please endeavor to keep cell phones and radios charged to the maximum extent possible.
