A “Maryland Boating Safety Education Certificate” will be awarded to participants who will successfully complete the course.

In Maryland, the law states that anyone born on or after **July 1, 1972**, must possess a **Certificate of Boating Safety Education** in order to operate any motorized vessel. This certificate is non-renewable and must be carried by the student at all times while operating a vessel. The Certificate must be shown on request, to any Maryland Natural Resources Police Officer or other law enforcement officer.
