Wear your life jacket to work Day

Whether you're working in the office, at home, in the air, or on the water, all boating enthusiasts can participate in Wear Your Life Jacket at Work Day on Friday, May 16, 2025. This fun day is part of the Safe Boating Campaign, a global awareness effort that encourages boaters to make the most of their boating adventure by being responsible.

Here's how to participate:

- Wear a life jacket wherever you work
- Snap a picture
- Post the picture on social media with the hashtag #wearyourlifejacketatworkday
- Tag the Safe Boating Campaign (@boatingcampaign)

Boaters will randomly be selected to win prizes from the Safe Boating Campaign throughout the day.

U.S. Coast Guard statistics show that drowning was the reported cause of death in three out of every four recreational boating fatalities in 2023, and that 87 percent of those who drowned were not wearing life jackets.

There are many options for boaters when it comes to choosing a life jacket. When selecting a life jacket, a boater should check that it is U.S. Coast Guard approved, appropriate for the water activity, and fits properly.

Partnership

The U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and West Marine have formally renewed and expanded their longstanding partnership through a Letter of Intent (LOI) signed in 2025 by the National Commodore and the Chief Director of the Auxiliary.

This collaboration, supported by the Coast Guard Auxiliary Association, revitalizes a relationship that began in 2004. Following a highly successful 2024 pilot, this year's program officially launches a nationwide rollout—beginning now and building momentum through National Safe Boating Week (NSBW) and the entire 2025 boating season. As of today, many Flotillas have already engaged in multiple preparatory NSBW events for 2025.

As part of a renewed national partnership with West Marine, all Flotillas are being asked to establish or re-engage their local store managers to coordinate Recreational Boating Safety (RBS) outreach events this spring—starting immediately and peaking during National Safe Boating Week 2025.

Suggested Activities Include:•

- Vessel Safety Check Days (VE)
- Public Affairs booths or safety conversations (PA)
- Program Visits (PV)
- Public Education tables or handouts (PE)
- Recruitment efforts for the Auxiliary (HR)

West Marine will support the program through marketing, in-store materials, and customer incentives for completing a Vessel Safety Check.

Action Items:

- 1. Contact your local West Marine store manager
- 2. Propose one or more outreach events during April and May
- 3. Share your plans with Division Leadership and with our National RBS Outreach contacts.
