Palm Coast Flotilla 41 completes first Safety Patrol for 2016

Palm Coast Flotilla 41 (four one) completed its first Safety Patrol for 2016. A Coxswain and two qualified crew members traversed their entire ICW area from High Bridge to Matanzas Inlet on Saturday 17 September 2016. They removed some dangerous objects from the water and towed a boat in distress to a safe harbor.

They plan to patrol regularly as they now have two operational facilities and qualified crew members attached to the Palm Coast Flotilla.
