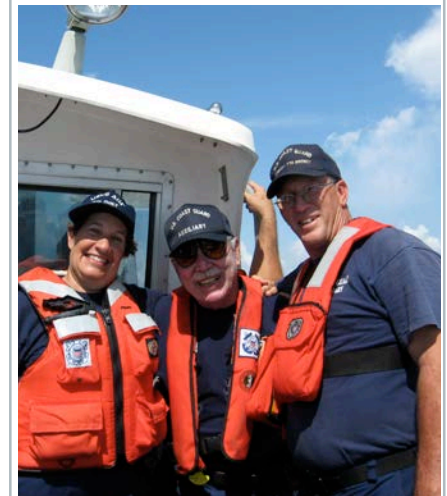

Do you have a Spirit of Patriotism and Volunteerism?

For those interested in boating, the Auxiliary offers a rigorous level of hands-on training and qualification as boat-crew and coxswain. Qualified Auxiliarists perform regular safety patrol missions in their local area.

In addition, the Auxiliary works side-by-side with their active-duty USCG counterparts in many mission areas. Auxiliarists receive training virtually identical to that of their active duty and reserve counterparts.

However, the Auxiliary has no law enforcement power and does not play any law enforcement role.

The Boat Crew Qualification program consists of in-depth seamanship and boat handling training followed by a series of proficiency tests, both written and practical. At some point you may wish to participate in the advanced operational Auxiliarist (AUXOP) Program. These cover patrols, communications, administration, seamanship, search and rescue, piloting, navigation, weather.
