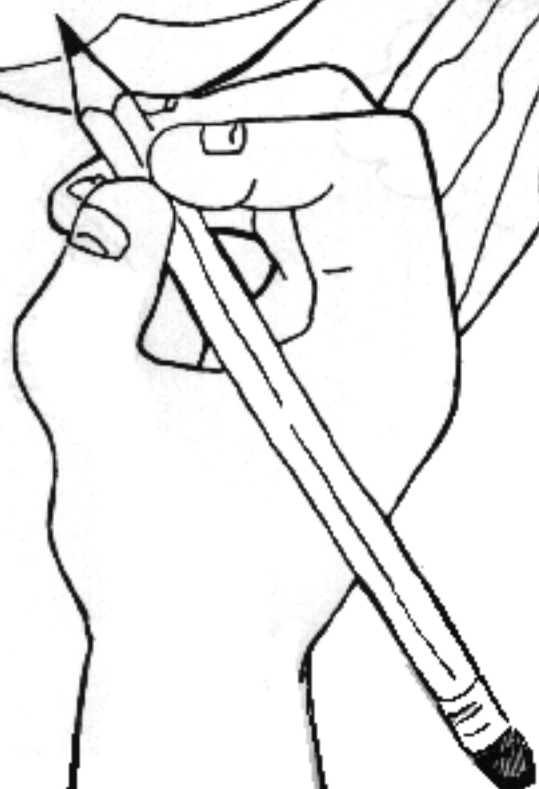


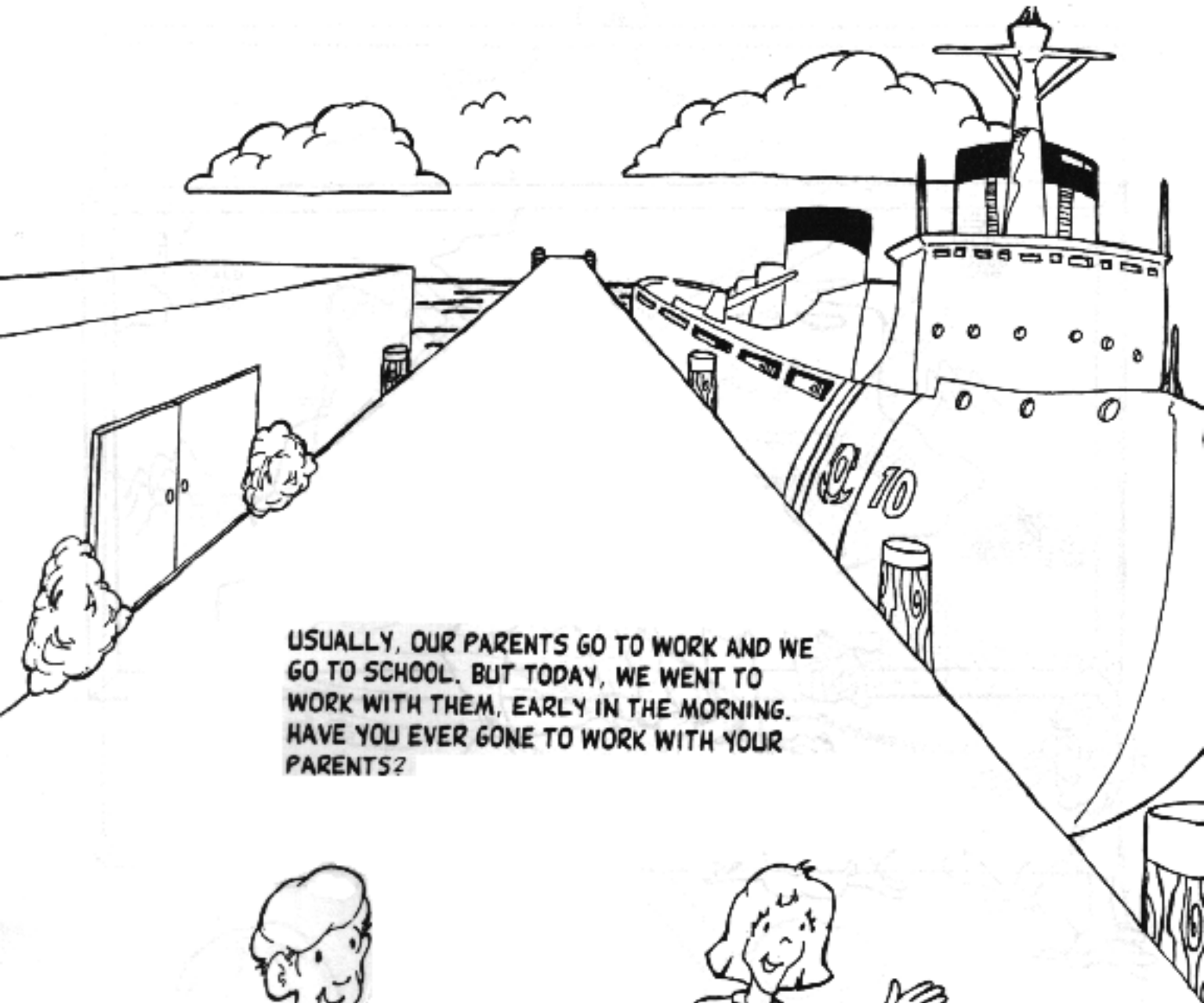


OUR DAY

GUARD

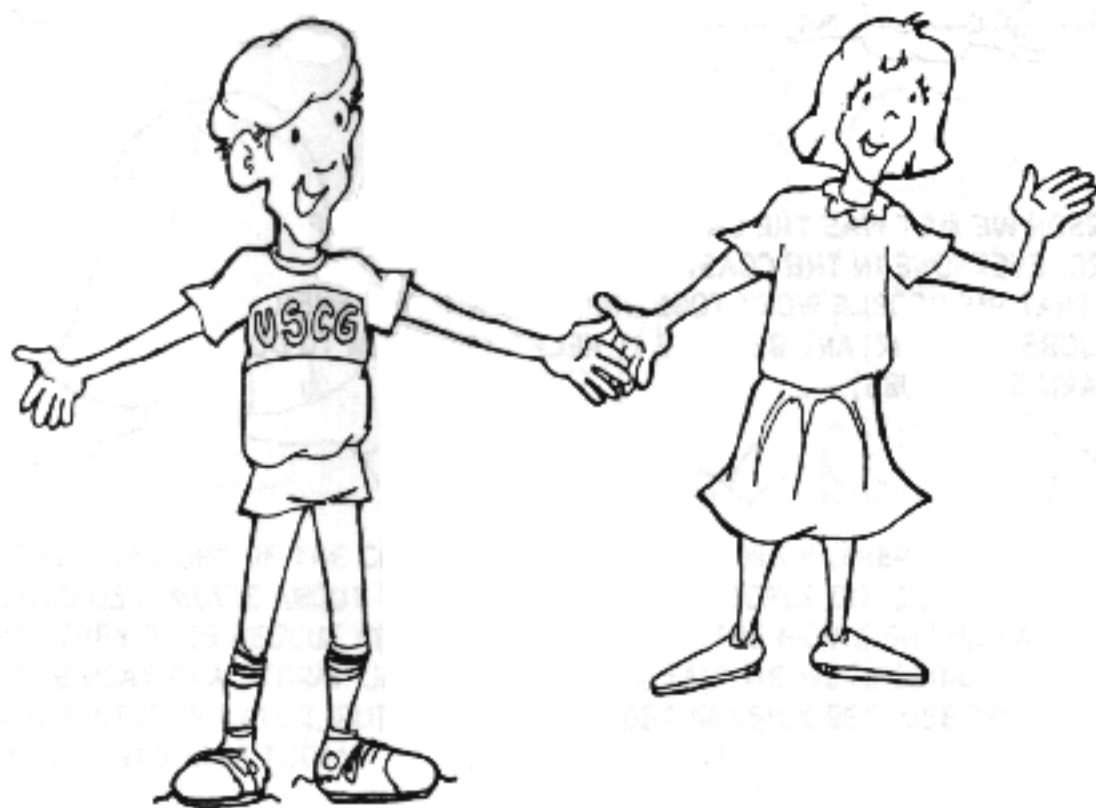
MY FRIEND, BILLY, AND I WOULD LIKE

THEY HELP PEOPLE.



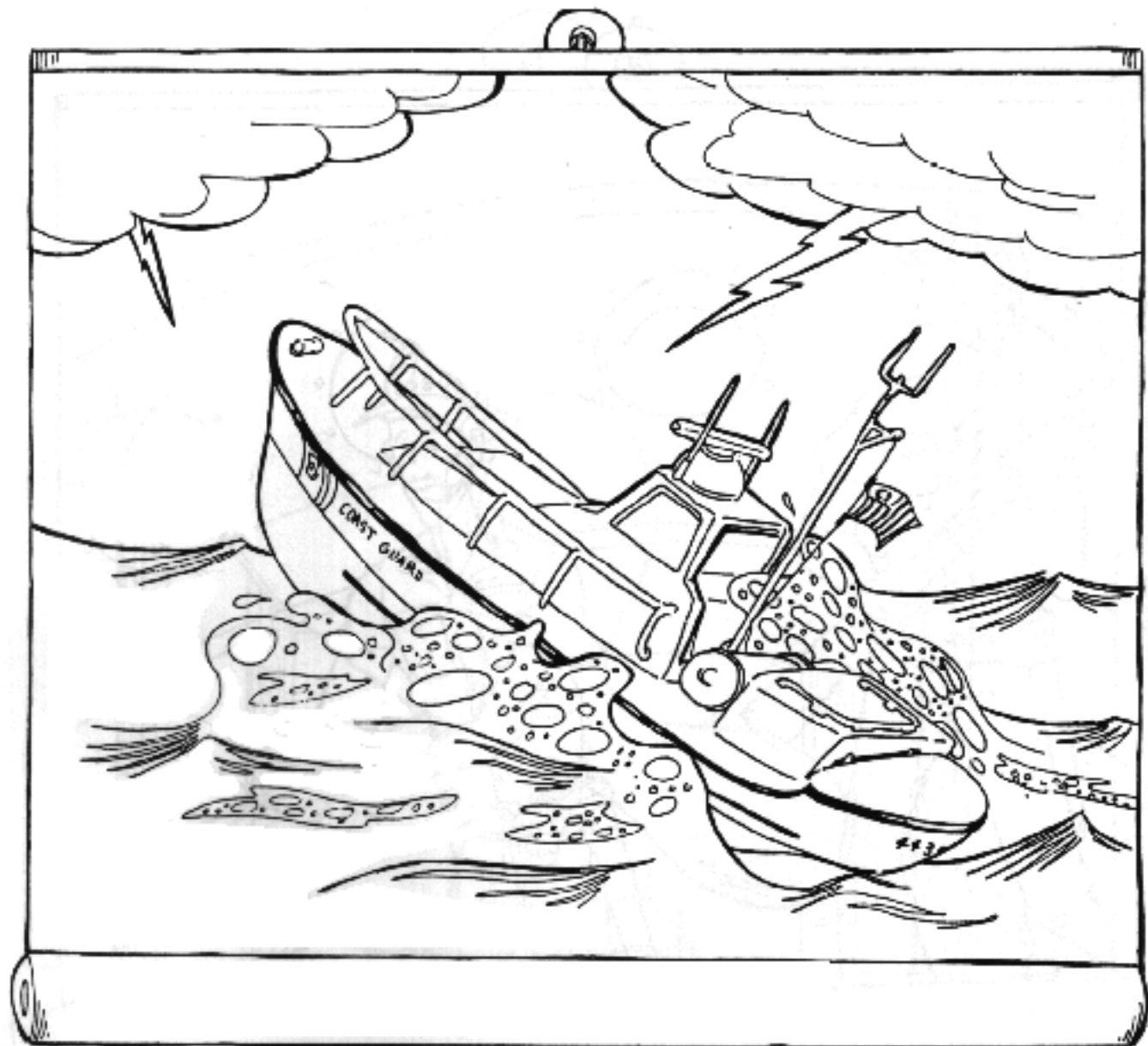

RESCUE COORDINATION CENTER

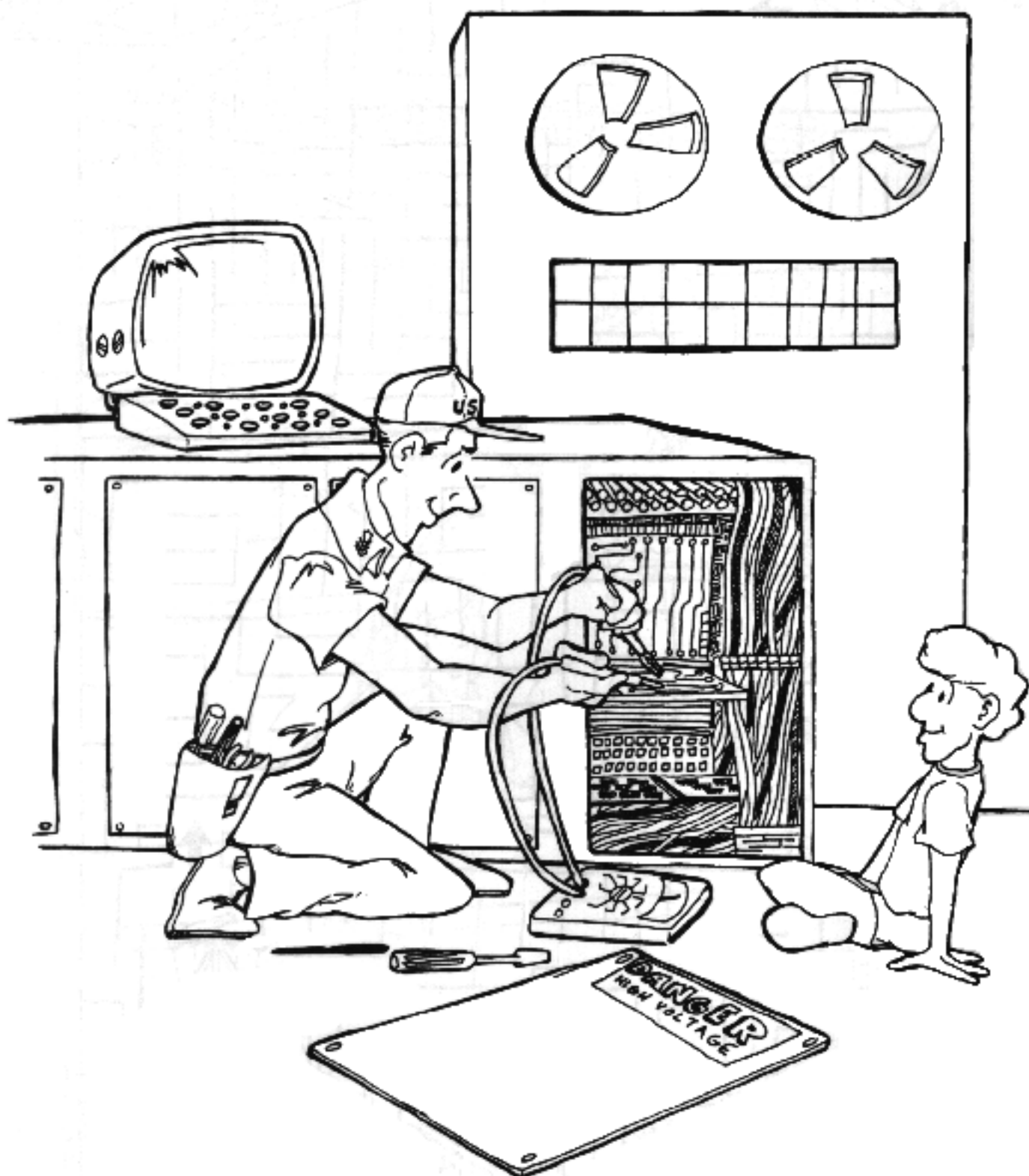

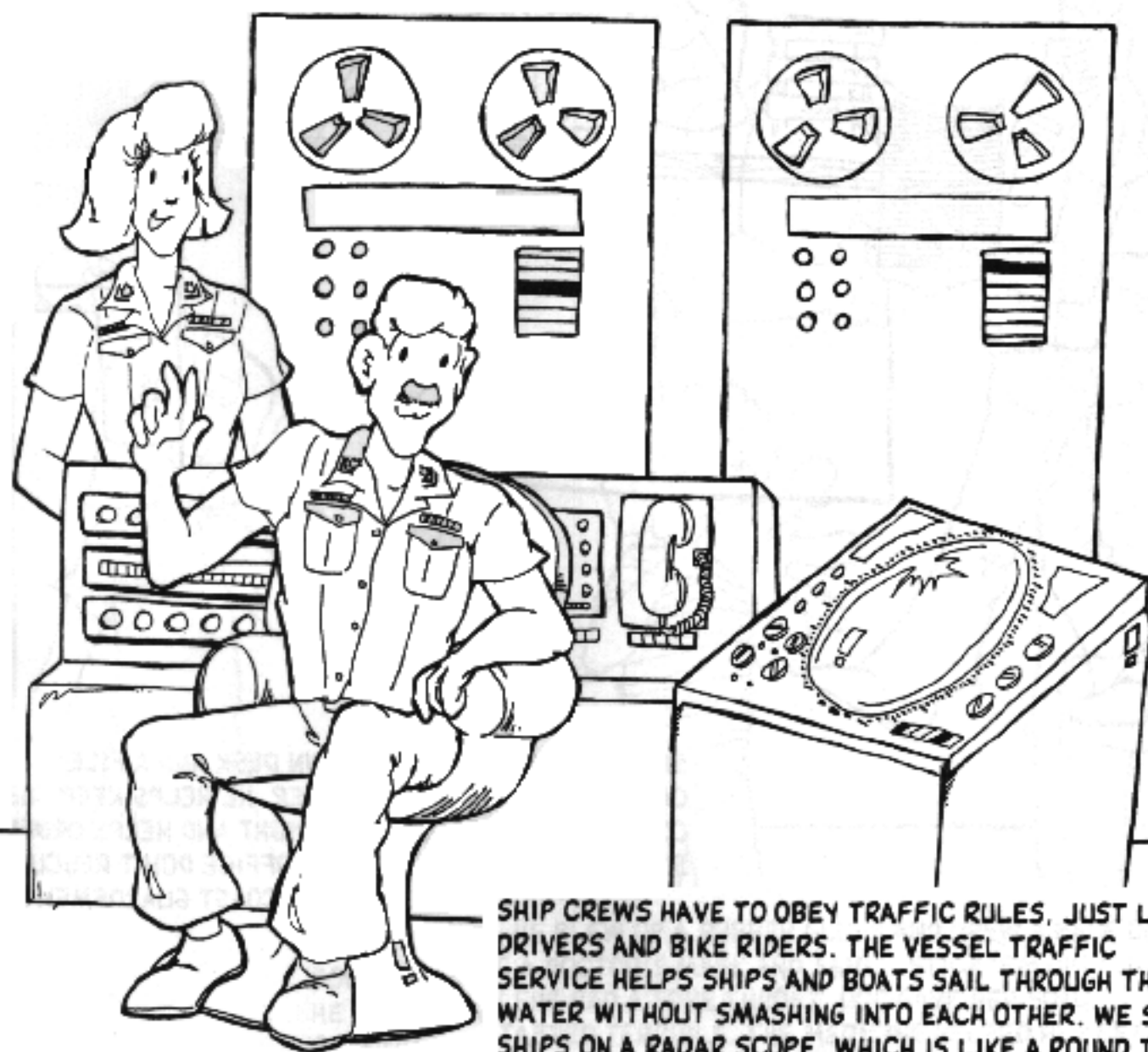
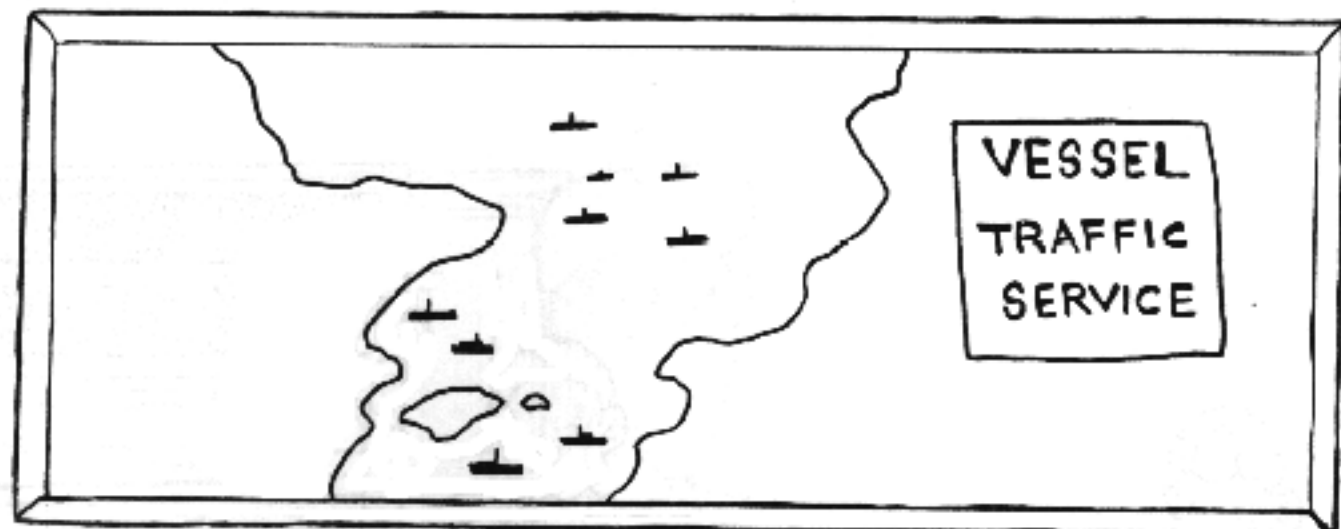
PEOPLE IN TROUBLE CALL FOR HELP. WE HEARD A VOICE ON THE RADIO SAY A FISHING BOAT WAS SINKING. THE PEOPLE IN THE RESCUE CENTER SENT A BOAT AND A HELICOPTER TO SAVE THE CREW.



HELP THE COAST GUARD SEARCH FOR THE BOATER IN TROUBLE. WHO WILL RESCUE THE MAN FIRST? THE COAST GUARDSMEN ON THE HELICOPTER, THE AIRPLANE, THE BOAT OR THE CUTTER? THEY ALL WORK TOGETHER TO SAVE LIVES.

SOMETIMES.



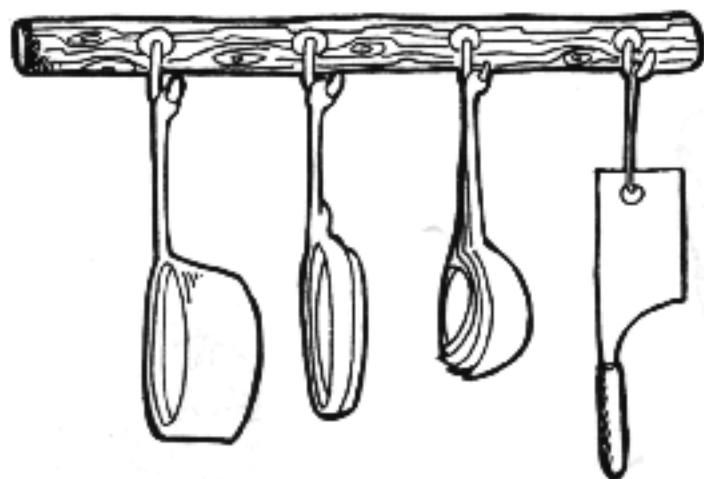
SHIP CREWS HAVE TO OBEY TRAFFIC RULES, JUST LIKE DRIVERS AND BIKE RIDERS. THE VESSEL TRAFFIC SERVICE HELPS SHIPS AND BOATS SAIL THROUGH THE WATER WITHOUT SMASHING INTO EACH OTHER. WE SAW SHIPS ON A RADAR SCOPE, WHICH IS LIKE A ROUND TV SCREEN.



SHERRY'S FATHER HAD HIS OWN DESK AND A FILE CABINET WITH STACKS OF PAPER. HE HELPS KEEP THE COAST GUARD'S RECORDS STRAIGHT AND HELPS ORDER SUPPLIES. THE PEOPLE IN THE OFFICE DON'T RESCUE PEOPLE, BUT THEY HELP OTHER COAST GUARDSMEN DO THEIR JOBS.



DOC WAS FUNNY. HE BLEW UP A RUBBER GLOVE AND DREW A FACE ON IT. HE WAS WEARING A DOCTOR'S MASK AND SAID, "STICK 'EM UP!" JANICE SAID THAT WHEN SHE HAD A SORE THROAT, DOC GAVE HER SOME MEDICINE THAT TASTED TERRIBLE. THE MEDICINE HELPED HER GET WELL, THOUGH.

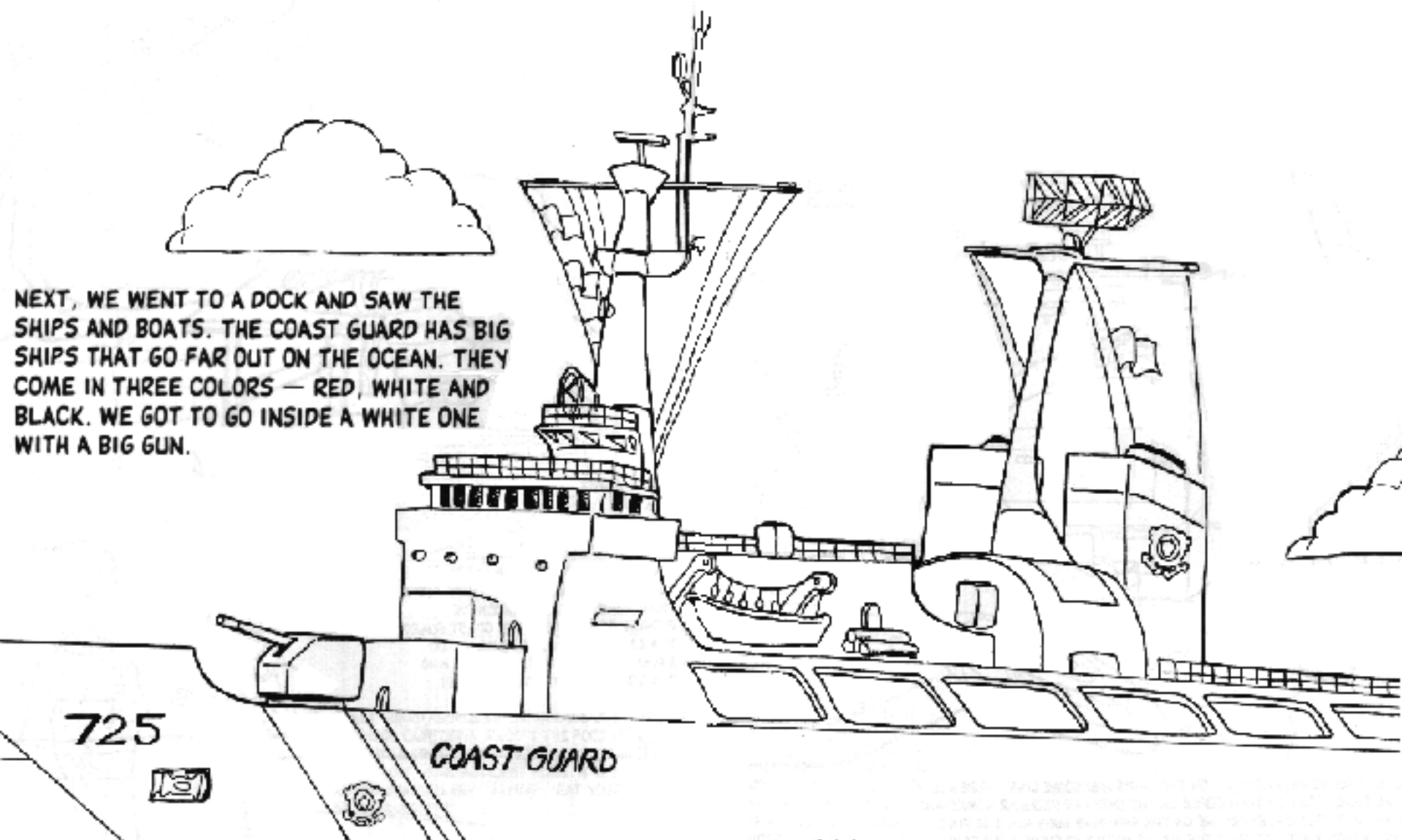

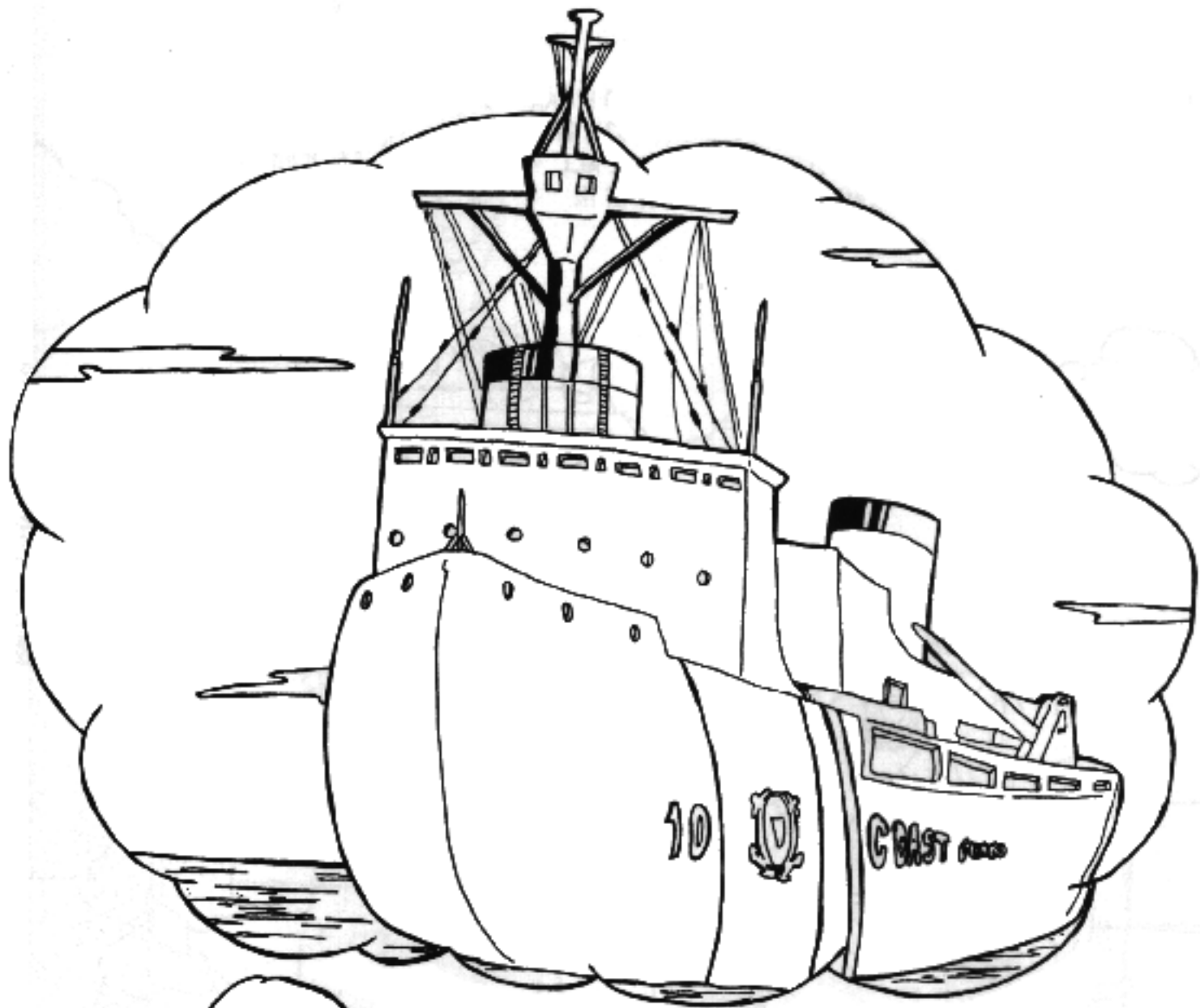

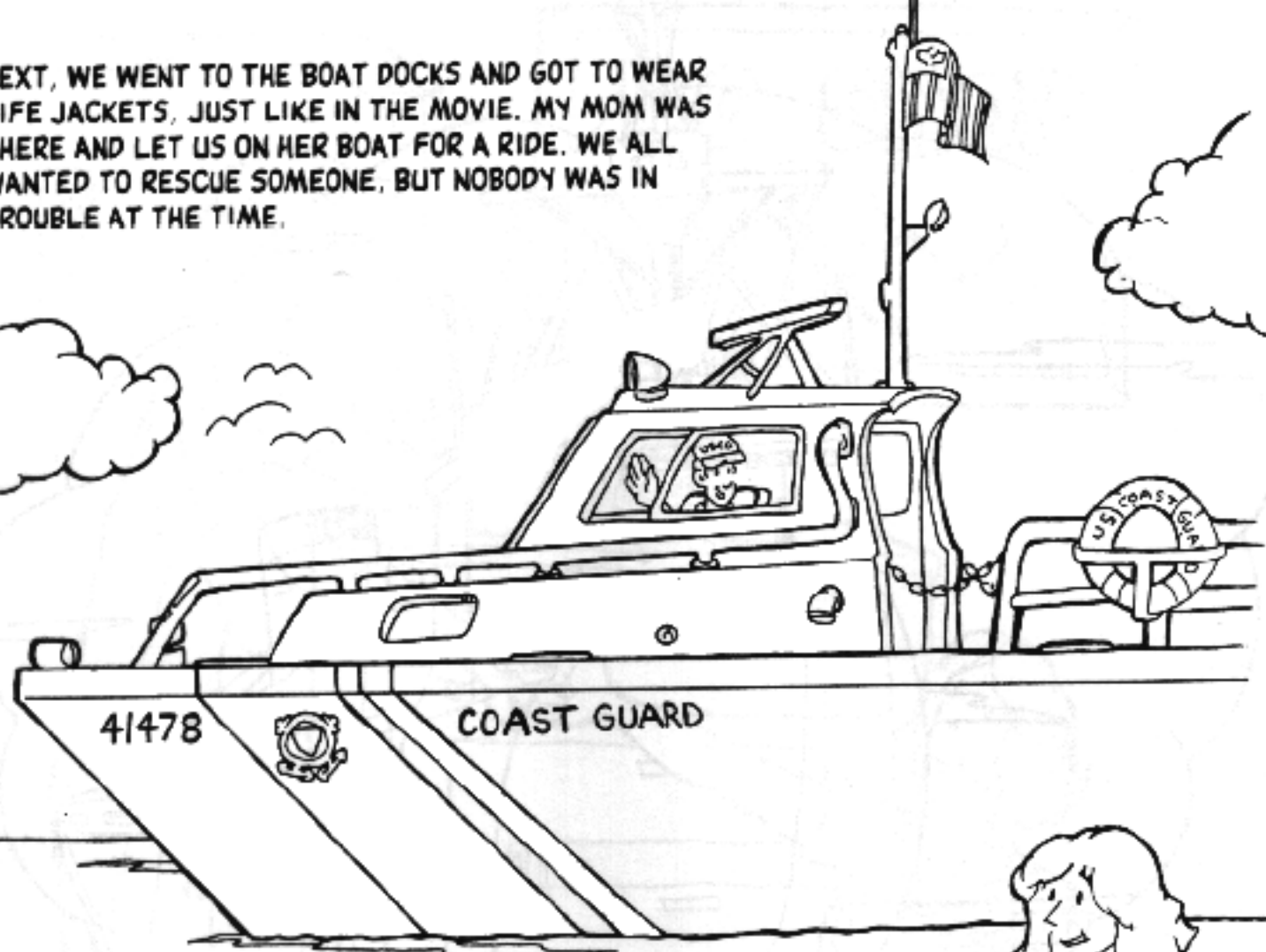

WORD FOR ME.



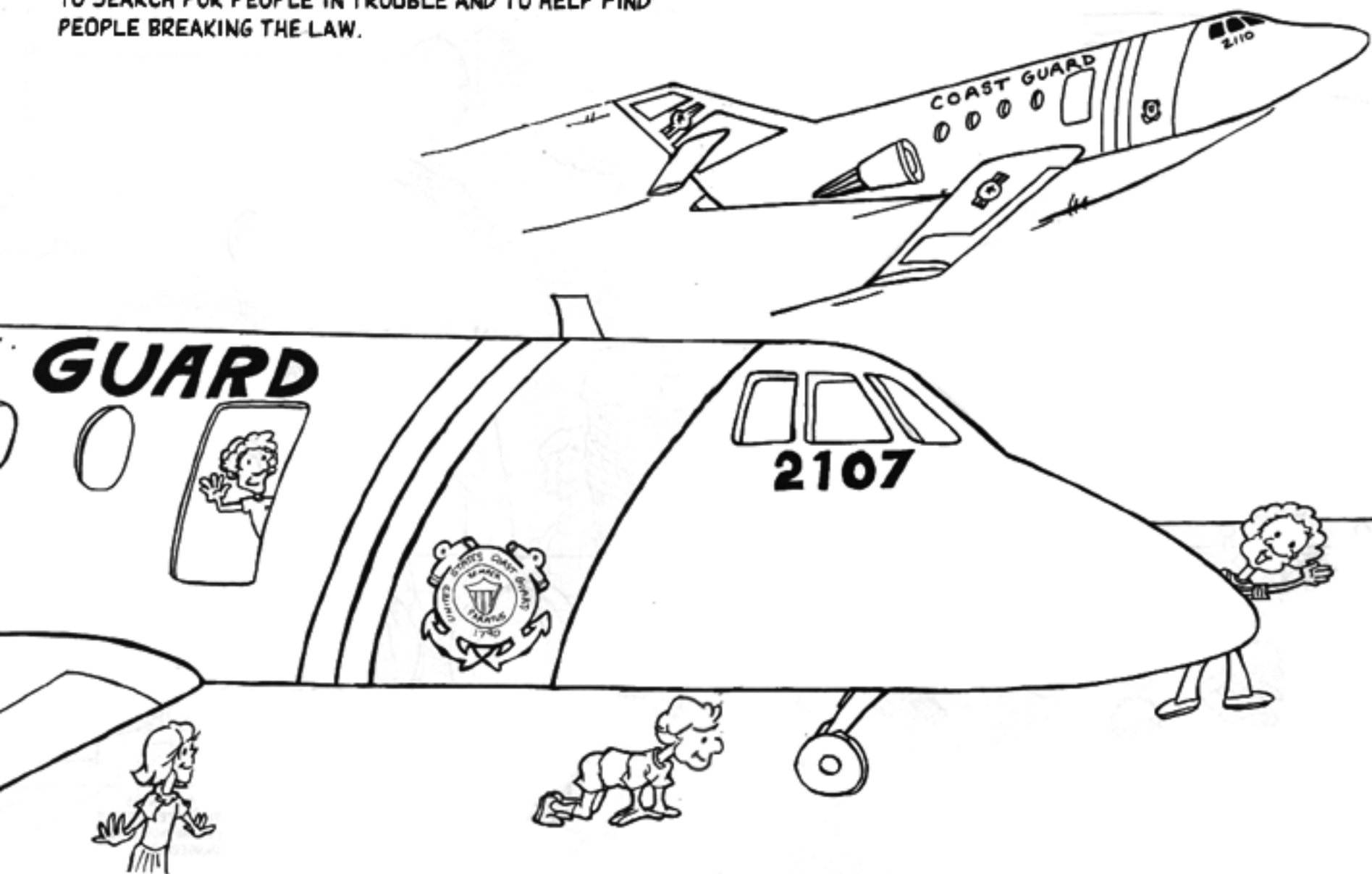

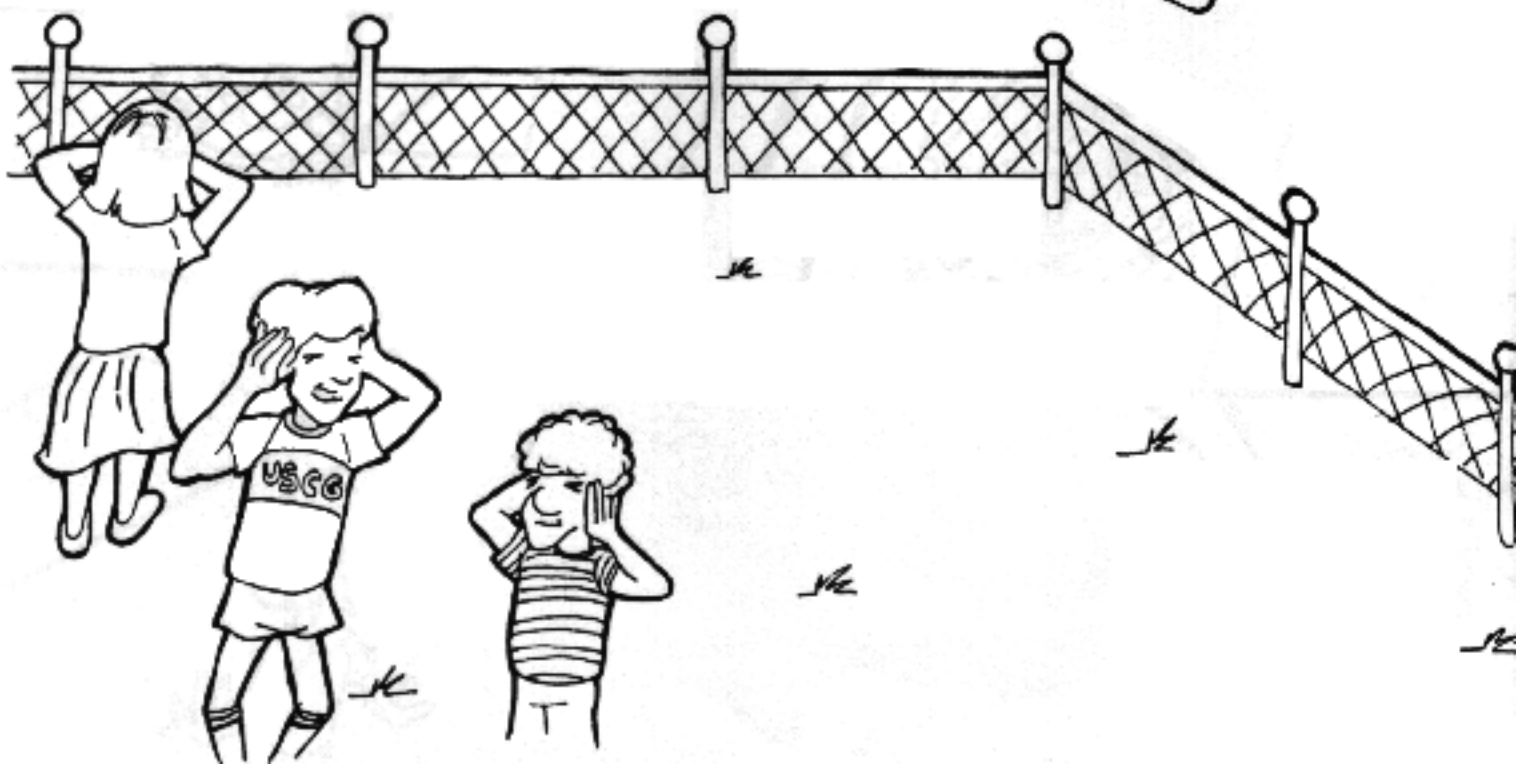
A COAST GUARDSMAN ON ONE BOAT HAD A GUN. HE PUT HIS HELMET ON HIS SON'S HEAD AND SAID HIS JOB WAS LIKE A POLICEMAN ON THE WATER. HE WAS GOING ON A PATROL TO STOP DRUG SMUGGLERS, JUST LIKE IN THE MOVIE WE SAW. SOMETIMES THE JOBS THE COAST GUARD DOES ARE DANGEROUS.

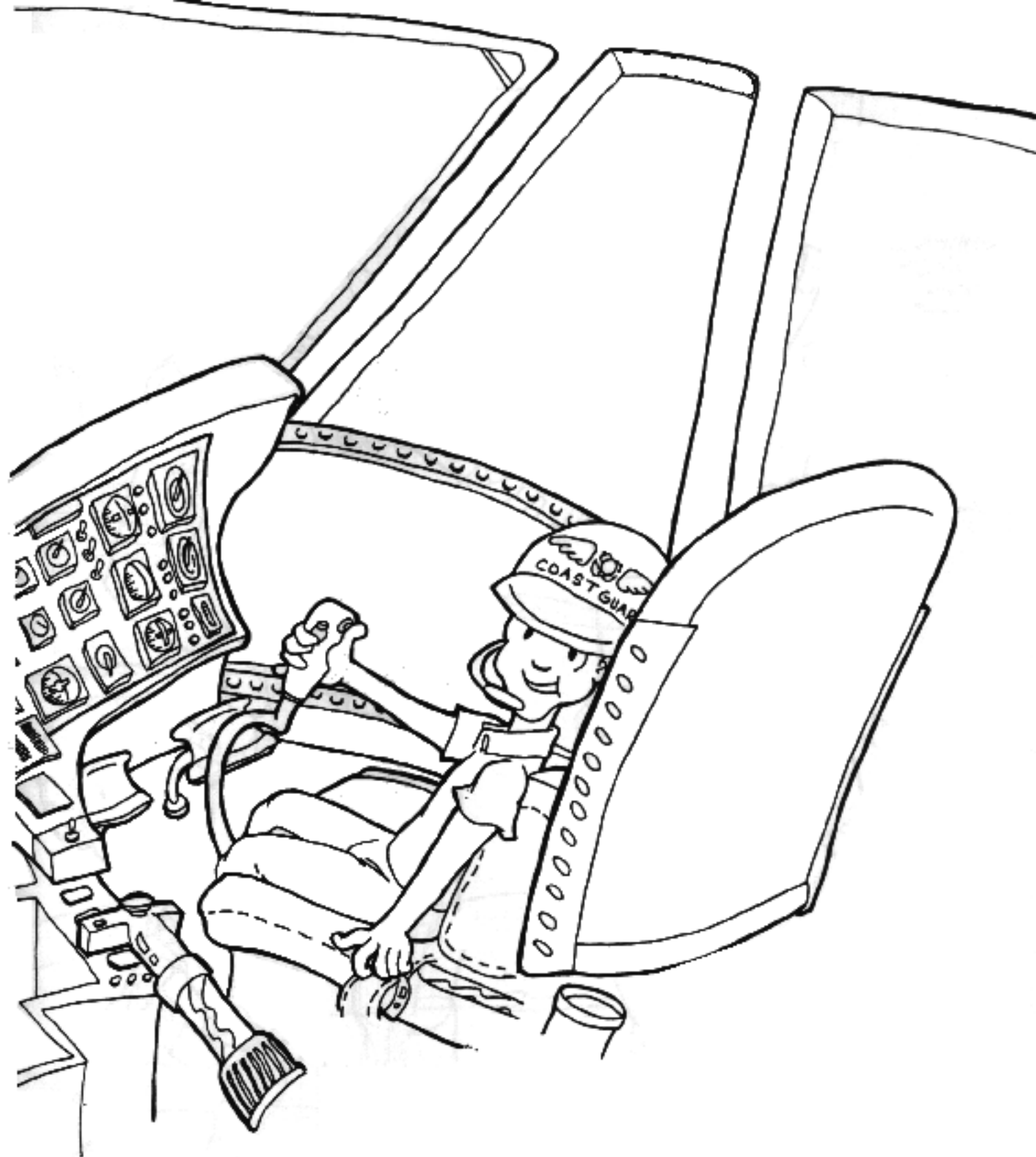
AFTER OUR BOAT RIDE, WE WENT INSIDE A REAL JET AIRPLANE. WE IMAGINED HOW IT WOULD BE ZOOMING THROUGH THE CLOUDS. THE COAST GUARD USES JET PLANES TO SEARCH FOR PEOPLE IN TROUBLE AND TO HELP FIND PEOPLE BREAKING THE LAW.





NEXT, WE WERE SUPPOSED TO SEE A HELICOPTER, BUT SOME PEOPLE RAN OUT TO IT AND FLEW AWAY. OUR GUIDE TOLD US THAT SOME PEOPLE WERE IN REAL TROUBLE AND NEEDED THE COAST GUARD TO HELP THEM. THE COAST GUARD'S BIGGEST JOB IS RESCUING PEOPLE IN TROUBLE.



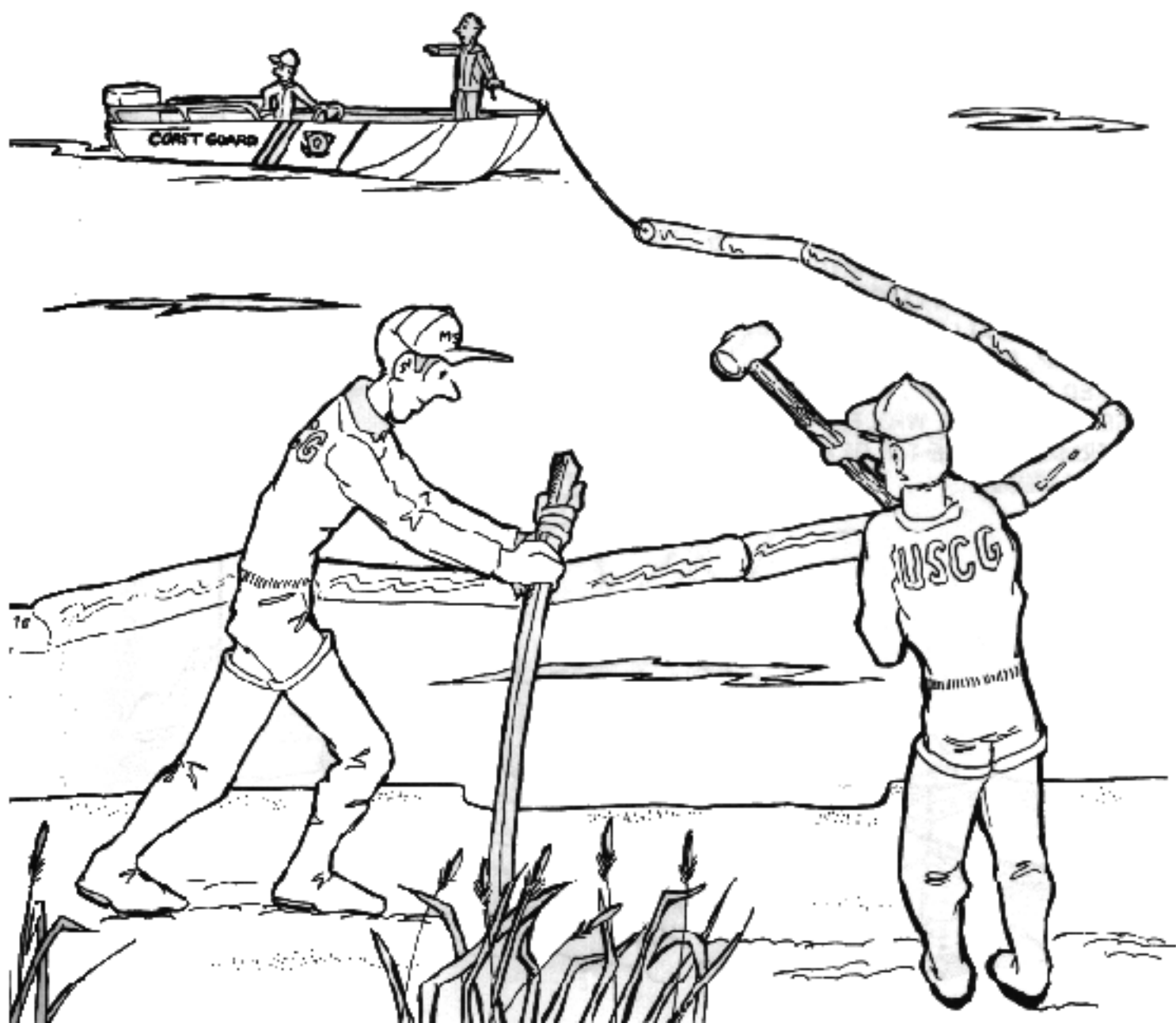

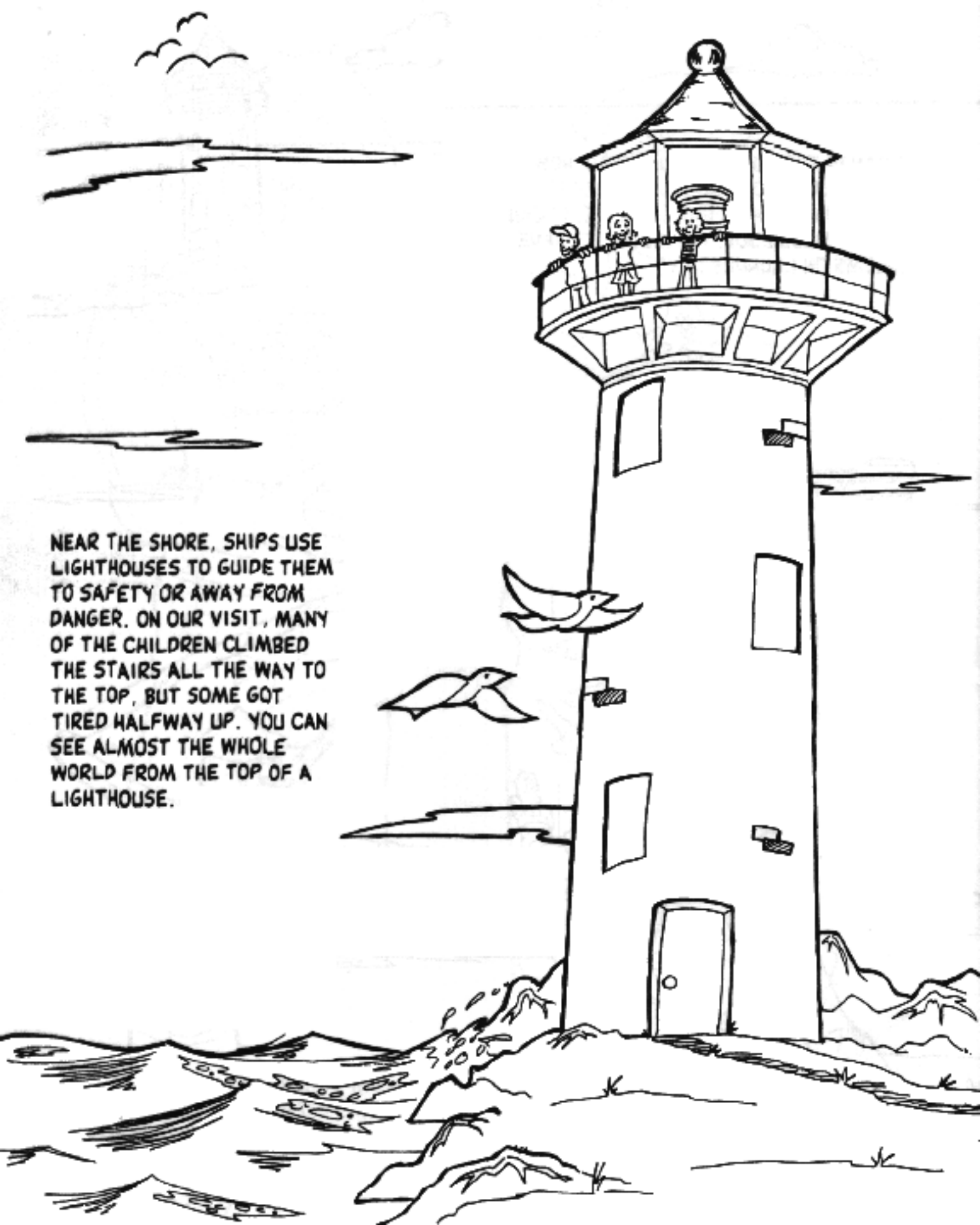


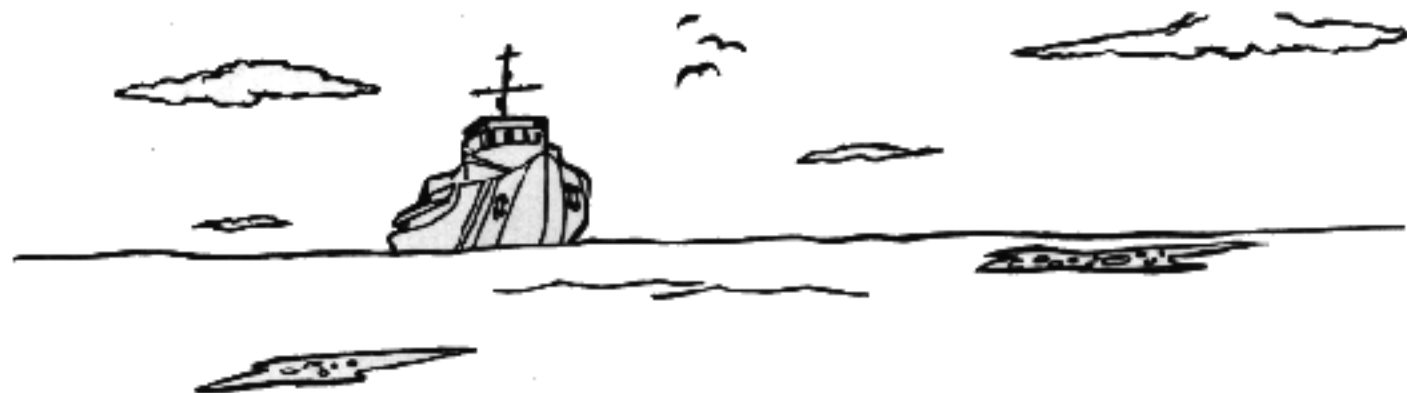
WE SAW A MAN IN A SPACE SUIT WHO LOOKED LIKE HE WAS READY FOR HALLOWEEN. HE WAS DRESSED LIKE THAT TO PROTECT HIS BODY FROM DANGEROUS CHEMICALS. THE COAST GUARD HELPS CLEAN UP OIL AND CHEMICALS WHEN THEY ARE SPILLED ON LAND OR IN THE WATER.

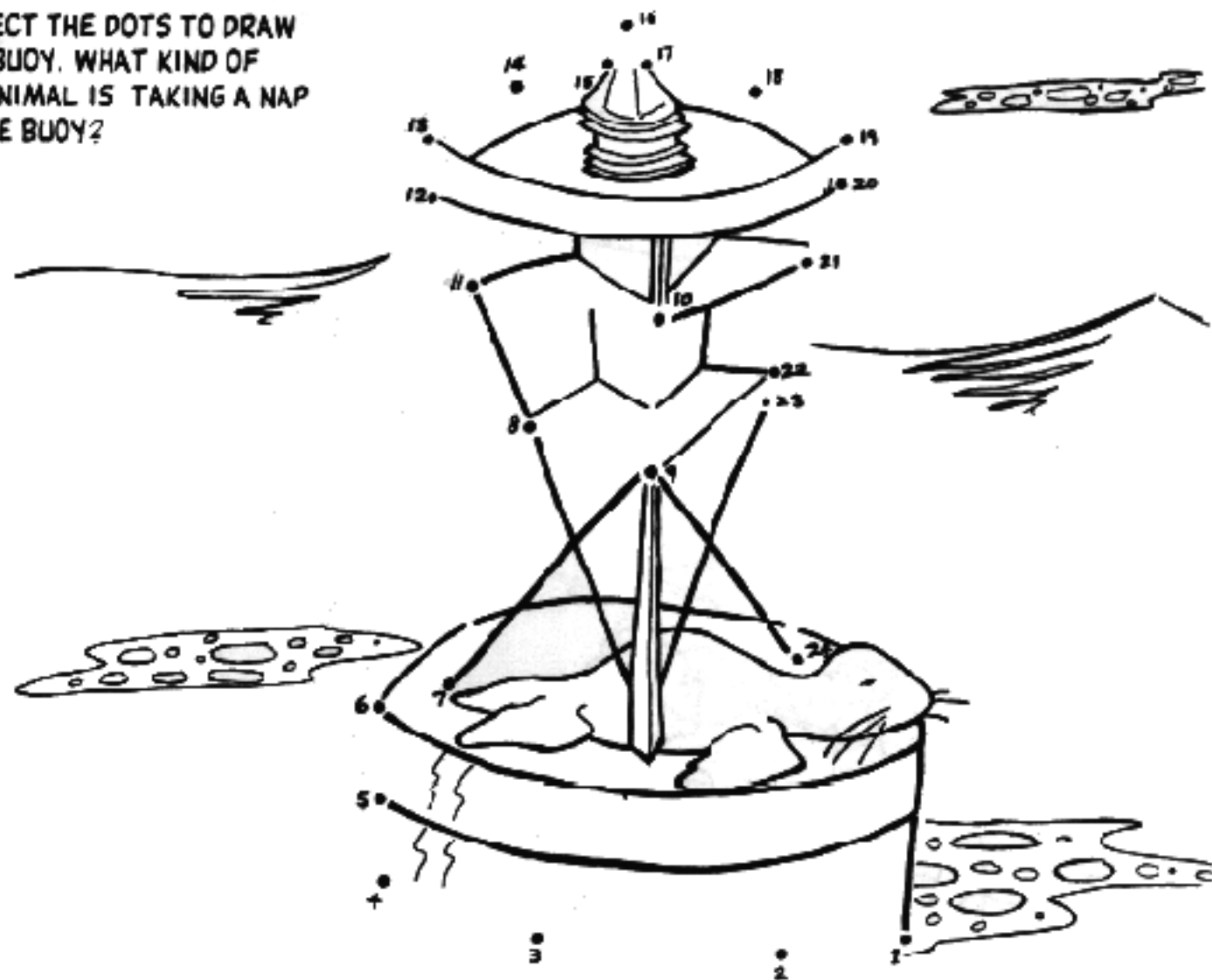
NEAR THE SHORE, SHIPS USE

LIGHTHOUSE.

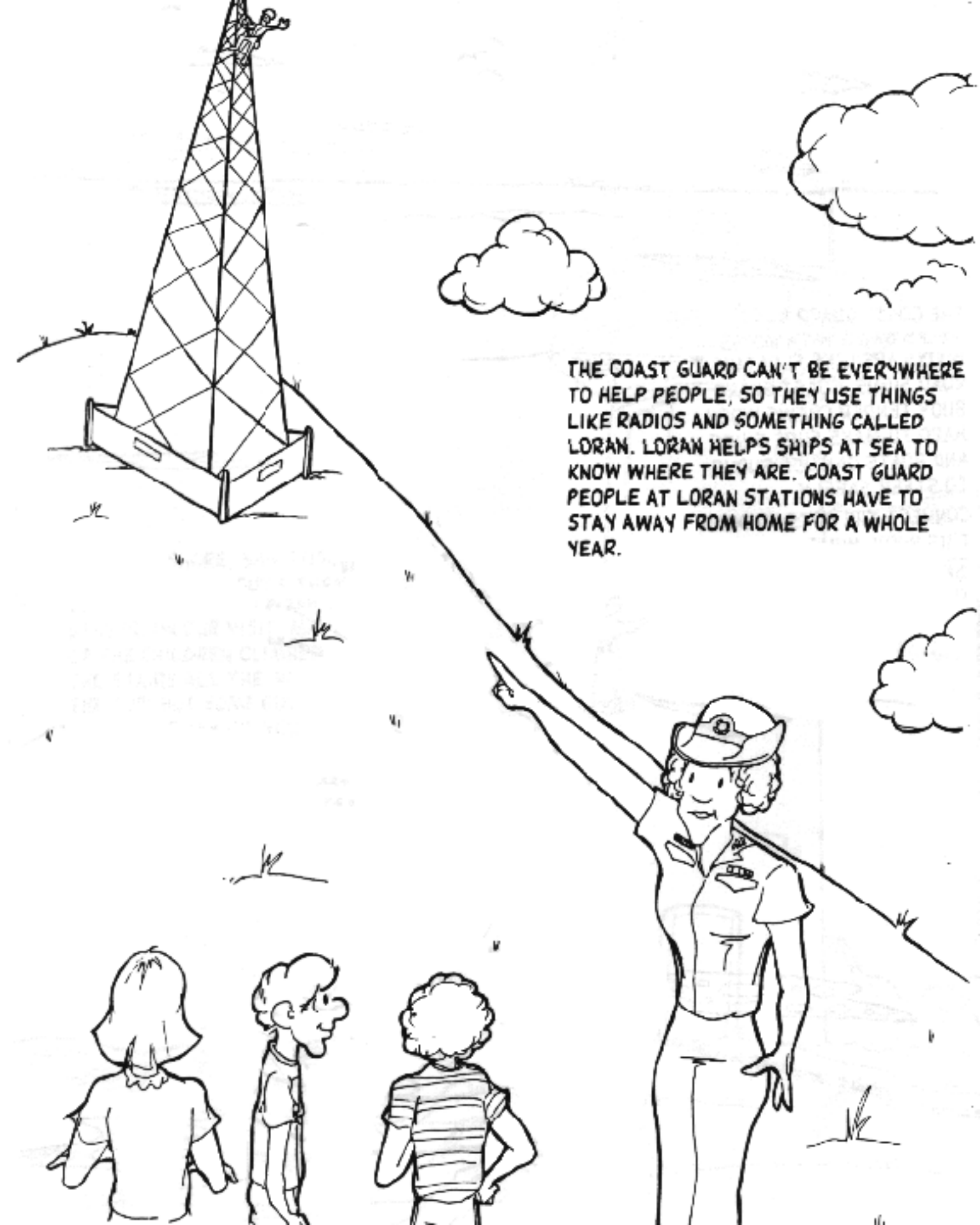




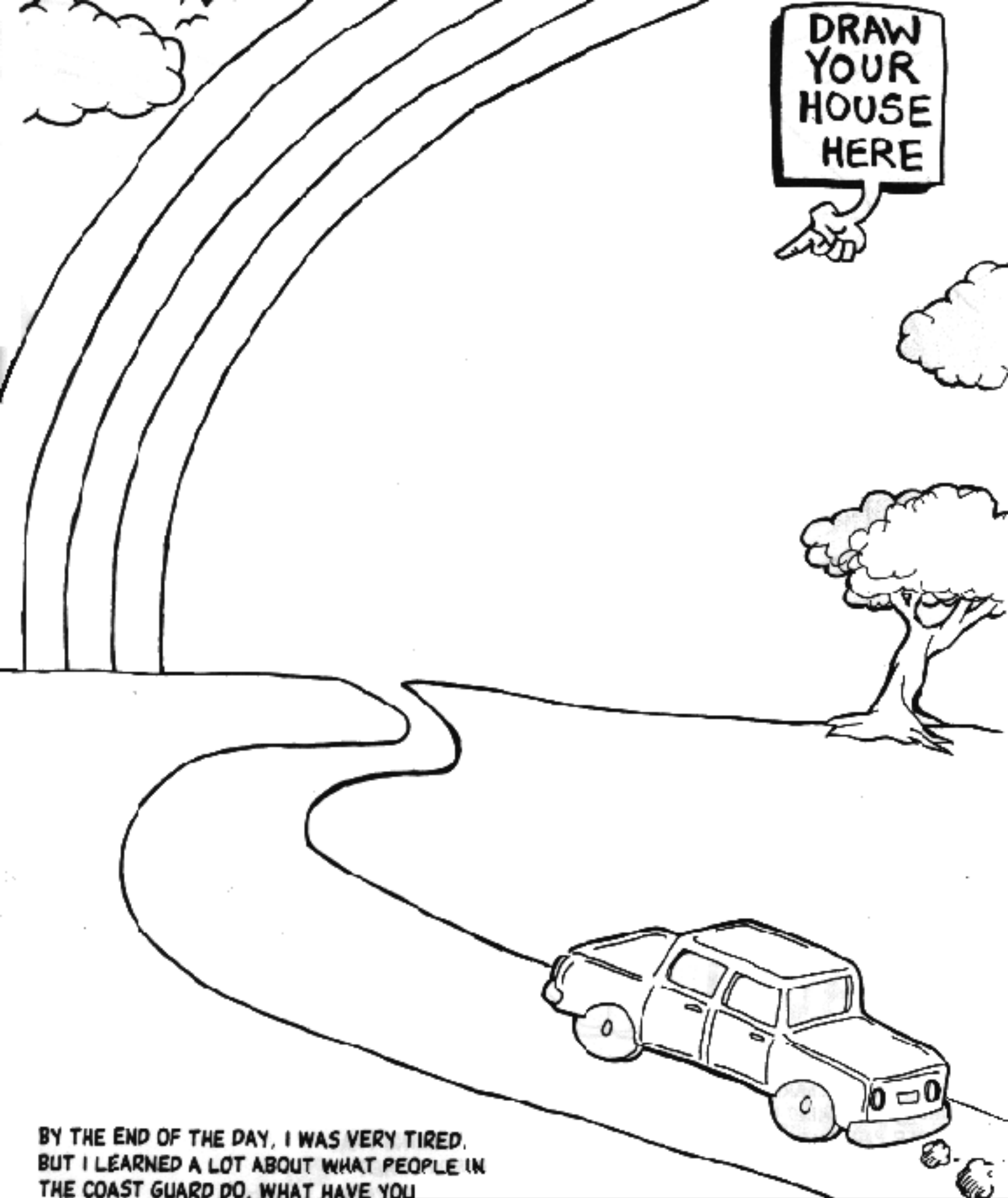

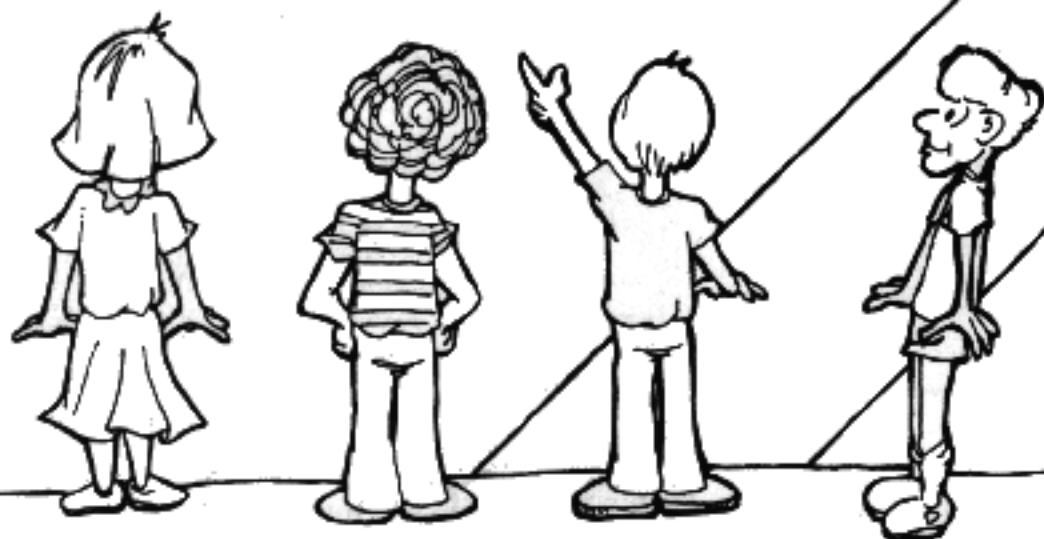
