

New Port Richey Flotilla 11-6 veterans were invited to participate in a "Veterans Day Dinner honoring the veterans who have served our country."


The event was held Veterans Day, at the Spartan Manor in New Port Richey Fl.

Remember for expenses on the 7029, please only record expenses for tolls, parking, meals and lodging that you were not reimbursed for. Read the instructions on the back of form to find the category or categories that you are in. Click here for instructions on filling in the 7030 form.
