

ATON Mission turns into a SAR

3 February, New Port Richey, Gulf Harbors, South Channel. On a recent Aids To Navigation (ATON) mission there became a necessity to do a Search and Rescue (SAR). The narrative follows; Shortly after commencing our ATON patrol, we came across a 14' vessel in the South Channel of Gulf Harbors, New Port Richey. The operator was struggling with his O/B motor, attempting to start it. Upon inquiring if he needed assistance, he indicated he was unable to restart his engine and would appreciate a tow to his dock about a mile away. Since he had no towing insurance or friend available to tow him home, we requested permission from [Station Sand Key] SSK to take him in tow. Upon receiving permission to take the D/V in tow, we proceeded to tow the D/V to his home dock, depositing him safely there.

There have been some reports lately of difficultly submitting Auxiliary Forms from the Internet. I have experienced this also, so here is what I did to get it to work:

1. Just opening the form on the internet does not mean it will work and be able to submit the form, for example 7029, 7030, 7038 and etc. (Especially using Windows 8).

2. You must download the form and then SAVE it to your computer, then go back to where you saved the form and then OPEN the form, fill it it and submit it.

3. This has worked for me using Google Chrome browser, let me know if you still have difficulty.

4. Always verify that the submission did in fact go thru, by checking to see if you received a receipt in your email (some forms update overnight, so check the next day).



Without funding there would be very little resources for things such as fuel and travel and other expenses. It is critical that you submit your time in hours spent and expenses. Form 7029 Activity Report is also important, even if you just read emails/write email/attend a meeting, you should be jotting the hours down on the 7029 worksheet. Remember for expenses on the 7029, please only record expenses for tolls, parking, meals and lodging that you were not reimbursed for. Read the instructions on the back of form to find the category or categories that you are in. <u>Click here for instructions on filling in the 7030 form.</u>
