Here are the steps to begin your new activities in Operations at Auxiliary Flotilla 1308:

1. Get your member Zone Password:

3. You need to have an ODU uniform prior to starting underway training. Review the procedure for Uniform ordering. It is in the google drive folder.
4. **Call the Dennis Kahler((305) 394-4647) to be added to trainee list**
5. Download/print the Boat Crew Qualification Guide

6. Put the Guide in a three ring binder
