- The Coast Guard Auxiliary and the "Sea Scouts" signed a Memorandum of Agreement
  which will allow a close working relationship between our two organizations. There are a

- Everbridge is still a valuable tool and the Coast Guard reemphasized the importance of being able to account for all of our members after an emergency. We are all a part of Team Coast Guard. It's important we account for everyone's safety after an emergency. Please make sure you keep your FSO-IS informed of your current address, phone numbers and email address.
- There are plans to drop the requirement for FEMA training courses for ICS 100 and 700 for our AP members. These courses will still be required for other training such as operations, food services, etc.
- The district purchased a WEEMS and PLATH **ELECTRONIC FLARE** for each flotilla. This new device replaces the requirement to carry flares aboard a vessel. The electronic flares are to be used for PA events, PE classes, and other events to demonstrate the newest in

boating safety equipment.
