

### INSIGNIA PLACEMENT


- Windbreaker and Trench Coat:
  Large metal insignia grounded on shoulder epaulets, "A" outboard
- Foul Weather Parka:
   Tab with insignia embroidered on ODU fabric centered on the front

- Bridge Coat:
   No insignia authorized. Replace Gold Buttons with Silver Auxiliary Buttons
- Wooly Pully/Cardigan Sweater:
   Soft shoulder boards on epaulets









### INSIGNIA PLACEMENT


- Combination cover:
   Replace gold chinstrap and buttons with silver
   Replace USCG Officer insignia with Auxiliary


- Replace USCG Officer insignia with Auxiliary
   Gartison Cover:
   Insignia 1.5" from bottom, 2" back from forward
   Left side CGAUX Insignia
   Right Side Office Insignia
   ODU Ball Cop
   Member or Office Insignia centered along the seam between "US COAST GUARD"
   and "AUXILIARY"











## TROPICAL BLUE LONG

- Required Insignia:
   Nametag, Centered ¼<sup>2</sup> Above Right Pocket
   For women, centered with bottom of name tag in line with top of third button
   Shoulder Insignia (Soft Cloth)

- Ribbons:
   If worn, three per row
   If not multiple of three, top row shall have less than 3
   Centered ¼<sup>\*</sup> above Left Pocket


SERVICE DRESS BLUE . . · . .

- Past officer device:
   If worn, ¼" below top of pocket
- AUXOP:
   If worn, ¼" above name tag

- Breast Insignia:
   Up to two may be worn
   First placed ¼" above top row of pocket
   or ribbons if worn
   Second placed ¼" below top of pocket

- In addition to tropical blue long:
- USCG Service Dress Blue Coat
   Replace gold buttons with silver Necktie (Male) or Tab (Female) Required
- Only authorized cover is Combination Cover
- Insignia Placement same as TBL
  - Long Sleeve shirt may be worn Bridge Coat/Trench Coat Authorized
- Windbreaker or sweaters may be worn in lieu of SDB coat unless situation dictates otherwise
- Insignia is sleeve striping sewn on the sleeve with USCGAUX device above








## **DINNER DRESS BLUE/WHITE JACKET**

- . Worn for formal occasions
- Jackets, trousers/skirts, and shirts procured from USN
- .
- Replace USN buttons and gold chain with CGAUX buttons and silver chain
- Shoes shall be high gloss military dress shoes
- .
- Black bowtle/tab .
- Silver cummerbund .
- Combination cover for males

- Insignia Placement:
   All uniforms:
   Metails and initiature insignia centered on left lapel in line with second button from top.
   Blub Jacket:
   Steese straining in the manner of SDB
   White Jacket:
   Hard Shoulder Boards
  - Outerwear:
  - Trench Coat
    Bridge Coat
- No cover for females



## FIRST, WHEN NOT TO WEAR IT

- Wearing of the Auxiliary uniform without proper authority is a violation of law. Prohibited occasions for wear include: a. In places of dubious reputation where the uniform might be discredited

- specifically authorized by an appropriate Coast Guard authority.

- Authorization may be granted in the following cases: (1) A scheduled patrol or deployment that might enter foreign territories. (2) An authorized SAR mission involving foreign borders or territories.
- (3) Deployment or guest status aboard a Coast Guard cutter or aircraft (4) Visiting a foreign country as an Auxiliarist on official business.
