1. CONGRATULATIONS All PRIVATE AIDS WERE VERIFIED ON TIME:



We have completed 100+% of our 2017 D11 (dpw) assignments and on time. We checked (to date) a total of 867 Bridges, ATON & PATON in completing our annual goal & challenge of 100% with only 32 qualified & certified PQS Aid Verifier. Each year the Auxiliary is committed to verifying 100% of the total assigned bridges & private aids in Eleventh District. While this is called an objective or goal, in actuality, it is much more than that. Mainly because, if we don't complete this assignments, the D11 (dpw) are held responsible to complete them for us. 2. <u>NOAA Launches New Nautical Chart Catalog</u>: October 27, 2017 by NOAA Office of Coast Survey, Nautical charts at http://www.charts.noaa.gov/ChartCatalog/MapSelect.html With NOAA's new Nautical Chart Catalog, users can readily access raster data and charting products in list format. The website serves as a complement to the Chart Locator by providing search capability for any of NOAA's thousand plus nautical charts.

The catalog redesign simplifies the user experience by reducing the number of clicks it takes to access a product. Legacy website data has been consolidated into a single page which makes the searching process a more intuitive user experience. Responsive design has been implemented making the site both desktop and mobile friendly.

Additional searching and sorting functionality has been added to the new catalog to increase product accessibility. The redesign provides the ability for users to find and download NOAA RNC®, full-sized nautical charts in PDF format, BookletChartsTM, notice to mariners chart corrections, a list of chart agents, and the ability to view online images of raster (paper) charts.

A quick search of the entire chart suite is available on the main page if the user knows the chart number, title, or scale.



Some aspects of the legacy catalog are retained, including the interactive map that separates the catalog into eight main regions. Each region contains several sub-regions derived from the catalog PDF tables and images. The new catalog design provides the flexibility to add more data in the tables in the future.

Open Source Chart Plotter Navigation Software: The software is available for use on PC's and MAC OSX computers (note: cannot be used with IPAD's). You can download the software and charts for FREE and use them locally as a chart viewer or chart plotter system on your boat. With the addition of a GPS dongle (listed below) your laptop can become a fully operational chart plotter and with weekly updated chart databases available from NOAA/NOS you will have one of the most powerful tools for assisting the Coast Guard and NOAA in our Bridge Surveys, ATON & PATON verifications and Chart Updating programs.
