Course Description:

Intermediate ICS 300 provides training on and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the ICS. This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-100 and ICS-200 courses.

Course Objectives:

- Describe how the NIMS Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents.
- Describe the incident/event management process for supervising and expanding incidents as prescribed by the ICS.
- Implement the incident management process on a simulated Type 3 incident.
- Develop an Incident Action Plan for a simulated incident.

Target Audience:

Federal, state, tribal, and local emergency management and response personnel who require ICS-300 training within their organization. Typically, required personnel include all mid-level or senior management who will be involved in or supporting the response.

Funding:

Tuition is free for those accepted; there are no travel/salary stipends available for this offering and all incurred costs are the responsibility of the attendee or sending organization.
