

Incident Command System (ICS) Training

The USCG frequently operates under the Incident Management System or ICS. As a member of the USCG Auxiliary you will need to complete various ICS courses. These are short and can be completed at home on your own time. The ICS courses are taught by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and can be located here: training.fema.gov/is/




When you get to the page above click on the link shown next to the red arrow. That will lead you to the page below, click on the "Register for a FEMA SID" button.



That will take you to a page to enter your information, then at the bottom check the box "I agree to the Privacy Statement" and click "Register".

FEMA will email your Student ID number (SID) which you will need to take the ICS courses.

Once you have that go back to the <u>training.fema.gov/is/</u> page and select the IS Course List menu.


