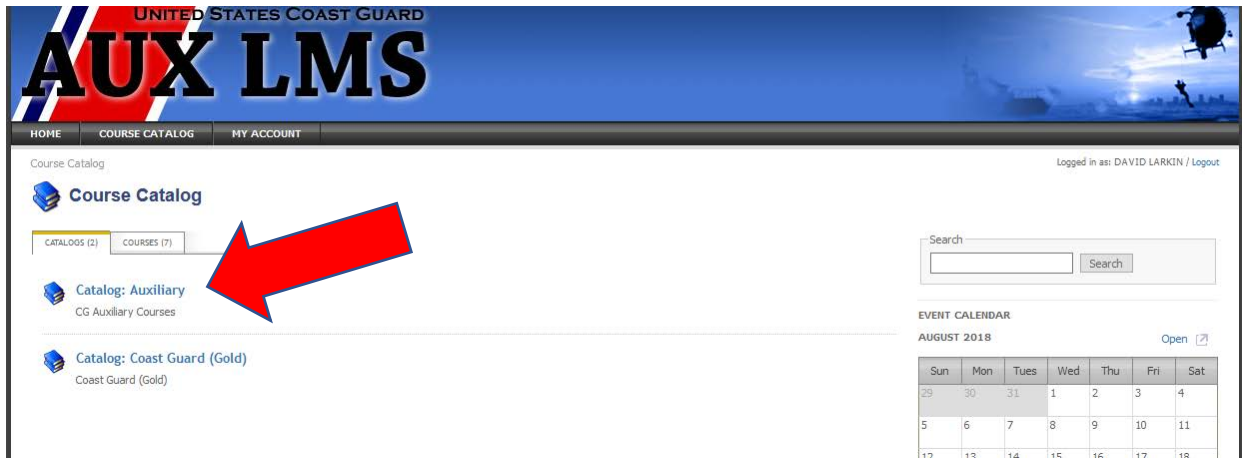

Risk is inherent in all we do. The dynamic and often uncertain nature of Coast Guard operations expose personnel to hazards that increase operational risk. A deliberate and systematic process is necessary to identify, assess, and control hazards and manage risk.
- 502325 - Incident Command System (ICS 210)**
This course prepares Type 4 Incident Commanders and First Federal Officials On-Scene to operate as single resource leaders in a Type 4 or Type 5 incident. Type 4 Incident Commanders could include coxswains, aircraft commanders, hoarding officers, pollution responders, facilities inspectors, and command center staff.
