## ALAUX 07-13 - ALCOAST 253/13 - AUXILIARY FOOD SERVICE SPECIALIST HEALTH RECORD VERIFICATION

## 10JUN2013

1. Recently released ALCOAST 253/13 formally changes the name of the AUXCHEF program to the Auxiliary Food Services (AUXFS) program, and the title of qualification is changed to Auxiliary Food Service Specialist (AUXFS). It also addresses AUXFS health record verification requirements, including the requirement for all current AUXFS to have their qualification records updated by October 1, 2013. 2. Auxiliary Food Service Specialists are authorized assignment to duty to support and augment dining facilities at Coast Guard units under the AUXFS program. When available, AUXFS should be considered first for provision of food service support at Auxiliary functions. However, nothing in the AUXFS program or the Auxiliary Manual, COMDTINST M16790.1 (series), prohibits Auxiliarists who are not qualified as AUXFS from providing food service support at such functions.
