2. Reference (b) was signed by the Chief Director of Auxiliary and Boating Safety (CG-BSX) on 20 February 2024. List of major changes can be found in its Letter of Promulgation.
3. References (b) and (c) contain the new standardization process and requirements for qualification and certification in the Auxiliary Boat Crew program. Some of the standardization processes include:
 - Auxiliary Standardization Evaluation Drill Sheets.
 - Qualification Examiner (QE) requirements and documentation.
 - QE request process.
 - Boat Crew Qualification Evaluation/Checkride requirements.
