- 1. This ALAUX announces the cancellation of reference (a) and the promulgation of reference (b).
- 2. Reference (b) was signed by the Chief, Office of Auxiliary and Boating Safety (CG-BSX) on 18 March 2024. A list of major changes can be found in its Letter of Promulgation.
- 3. No paper distribution will be made of this Handbook. An electronic version will be posted on the Chief Director of Auxiliary section of the Coast Guard Auxiliary web site: https://wow.uscgaux.info/content.php?unit=BX-GROUP&category=guides-and-handbooks. If the cited web link does not work, then access should be attempted by copying and pasting or typing the web site address into the user's internet browser.
- 4. In accordance with Chapter 2, Section A in reference (b), "The District Staff Officer Program Visitor (DSO-PV), Division Staff Officer Program Visitor (SO-PV) and Flotilla Staff Officer Program Visitor (FSO-PV) in the Auxiliary must be a certified Program Visitor (PV)." Current DSO-PV, SO-PV and FSO-PV not certified as a PV may continue to serve in their current position and are encouraged to get certified as a PV. Newly appointed members into these positions must be certified as a PV to serve in any of these appointed positions.
- 5. Internet release is authorized.

For many reasons including the value of keeping communication lines clear and open as well as facilitating access to training and educational tools, all Auxiliarists are urged to have their own email address and to keep it updated in AUXDATA II.
