Subj: AUXDATA II – ANTICIPATED SHUTDOWN ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2025

1. Unforeseeable contractual circumstances have yielded the likely prospect that the AUXDATA II information system will have to be secured from availability on September 20, 2025. While efforts are being made to sustain its availability without interruption, prudence dictates preparation for the shutdown of AUXDATA II on that date. Although an exact duration of its shutdown cannot be forecast at this time, a period of at least three weeks should be expected.
2. Auxiliary flotillas, divisions, and districts should work closely within their respective leadership and program management chains, and in collaboration with their District Director of Auxiliary offices and national program managers, to take timely preparatory action. For example, flotilla nominating committees should extract and download all necessary information to determine the eligibility of all potential candidates for the flotilla's elected offices.
3. AUXDATA II teams are aware of the situation. Additional information and guidance regarding the potential lapse in AUXDATA II, including follow-on contingency plans, will be forwarded as necessary to Auxiliary units for dissemination and action as they develop.
4. Internet release is authorized.
