Subj: CHIEF DIRECTOR'S FINAL ACTION ON NATIONAL BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS  
AT NACON 2024

---

1. At the 2024 Auxiliary National Convention (NACON), recently held in Orlando, Florida, three recommendations were placed before the National Board. They are copied below along with the Chief Director's final actions.

**a. Subject: Recommendation to Have All Auxiliary Members Be Also Members of the Auxiliary Association (Originator: Commodore Gus Formato / 29 May 2024)**

**(1) Recommendation:** It is recommended that all members who have enrolled from 20 JUL 2022 to date and going forward all new members, also become members of the Auxiliary Association, formerly known as AuxA.

**(2) Discussion:** In 2022 a recommendation was passed by the National Board and approved by BSX on 20 JUL 2022, that made provisions for a second 501C3 (sic), to be formed and members of the Auxiliary be removed from AuxA to gain a substantial reduction in insurance rates. However, it was determined that the substantial reduction could be achieved by changing insurance carriers instead of creating a second 501C3 and removing Auxiliary members from AuxA. The second 501C3 was not created and members were not removed from AuxA. This recommendation would have all members who enrolled since 20 JUL 2022 and all new members going forward become members of the Auxiliary Association, formerly known as AuxA.

**(3) National Board Action: Approved.**

**(4) Chief Director Final Action:** Concur, approved. This effectively reinstates the requirement for consent to Auxiliary Association membership by all Auxiliarists in order to comply with the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporations Act (the Auxiliary Association is incorporated in the District of Columbia).

(a) With issuance of this ALAUX, the continued Auxiliary membership of Auxiliarists who have enrolled since 20 July 2022 constitutes consent to membership in the Auxiliary Association. No additional action on their part is necessary.

(b) Effective immediately, an Auxiliary applicant must sign and submit the attached Auxiliary Association Consent to Membership form (AuxA-10) as part of their Auxiliary enrollment package. This form is posted on the Auxiliary Forms Warehouse (<https://forms.cgaux.org>). Consent to Auxiliary Association membership will be built into the next revision of the Auxiliary enrollment form (ANSC-7001).

**b. Subject: Realignment of the Diversity Directorate (Originator: Commodore Gus Formato / 1 June 2024)**

**(1) Recommendation:** Recommend that the D Directorate – Diversity and Inclusion be moved into the ForceCom (Mission Support) Group to be led (sic) by a Director with assistance from a Deputy Director, reporting to the Deputy National Commodore Mission Support (DNACO-MS) through the Assistant National Commodore ForceCom (ANACO-FC).

**(2) Discussion:** There was a time when it was expected that the (sic) active duty would expand its Office of Diversity and Inclusion. However, due to active duty realignment, the Office of Diversity and Inclusion is now incorporated into the Civilian Human Resources, Diversity and Leadership Directorate (Mission Support). Acceptance of the recommendation will further align the Auxiliary's organization with the active duty.

**(3) National Board Action:** Approved.

**(4) Chief Director Final Action:** Concur, approved. This realignment has been completed.

**c. Subject: Reorganize the Information Technology and Planning Group (Originator: Commodore Gus Formato / 1 June 2024)**

**(1) Recommendation:** Recommend reorganizing the Information Technology and Planning Group by eliminating the ANACO-PS Office, transferring the Student Programs Directorate to ForceCom, disbanding the Measurements Directorate and adding an additional Deputy ANACO to ForceCom (Mission Support) to maintain span of control after adding the Diversity and Student Program Directorates to ForceCom.

**(2) Discussion:** The dissolution of the Measurements Directorate will result in the majority of its functions being integrated into the U Directorate. The remaining functions will be reassigned to suitable directorates by the ANACO-IT. With the disbandment of the M Directorate and the integration of the S Directorate into ForceCom, the ANACO-PS will become redundant and thus will be dissolved. This reorganization will streamline the group. The new structure will maintain a DNACO-ITP (sic), an ANACO-IT, and introduce a Deputy ANACO-IT (a new position), all overseeing the U, C, and Y Directorates.

**(3) National Board Action:** Approved.

**(4) Chief Director Final Action:** Concur, approved. The transfer of the Student Programs Directorate to ANACO-FORCECOM has been completed. The disbandment of ANACO-PS and the M Directorate will be completed by 01 January 2025.
