Subj: POSTING OF AUXILIARY NATIONAL C-SCHOOL CALENDAR

1. The Auxiliary National C-school calendar for Fiscal Year 2025 has been posted at <u>https://wow.uscgaux.info/content.php?unit=aux00</u>. This first version only includes sessions that have already been scheduled up through April 2025. The calendar will be updated as additional sessions are scheduled. The training dates for currently scheduled sessions may shift, therefore Auxiliarists are strongly encouraged to periodically check the calendar for changes that occur throughout the year.

2. Members interested in attending a C-school can now submit a Short-Term Training Request (STTR, form ANSC-7059; available at <u>https://forms.cgaux.org/forms1.php</u>) in accordance with the form's instructions and associated Auxiliary district policy.

3. Please note that funded training quotas are much more limited than in previous years. Many courses will therefore have fewer sessions and will be able to accommodate fewer students. A few courses will only have virtual options available this year. Only in-person sessions, and not virtual sessions, are listed on this calendar. Members who are interested in attending an in-person C-school should review that course's description and prerequisites and submit a STTR as early as possible. Members may attend an Auxiliary C-school on unfunded orders issued by their District Director of Auxiliary (DIRAUX), but they must first check with the listed course Point of Contact (POC) to make sure there is space to accommodate such a request, and they are responsible for arranging the provision of orders with their DIRAUX office. For certain C-school courses there may be opportunities to hold additional sessions at DTRAINs for attendance by local students, though these opportunities will be limited. Requests to do so should be submitted to the identified course POC.

4. Any questions about a course, including about its description and prerequisites, can be answered by checking the C-School Student Support Sites. The links to the sites are located at the bottom of the Auxiliary C-School page at <u>https://wow.uscgaux.info/content.php?unit=aux00</u>. A member can also contact the course POC directly using the contact information provided on the Auxiliary National C-School calendar.

5. Internet release is authorized.

For many reasons including the value of keeping communication lines clear and open as well as facilitating access to training and educational tools, all Auxiliarists are urged to have their own email address and to keep it updated in AUXDATA II.

*** ETQC WILL NOT ISSUE NO-COST ORDERS AND NO-COST STTR'S DO NOT NEED TO BE ENTERED INTO DA, ONLY FUNDED ORDERS. If the District is interested in holding an exportable session in which instructors are funded to the District's training site under C-school orders and local students attend on unfunded orders, please contact the POC for the C-School or the PM at the CHDIRAUX office.

***CG Academy and TRACEN Petaluma are not handicap-accessible facilities. They are not recommended for anyone having difficulty walking. Both locations have significant hills and vehicles cannot be parked near the berthing or training facilities.

All DIRAUX are to follow all procedures set forth for canceling and notifying ETQC & CG-BSX-11 Program Manager via message traffic as per COMDTINST M1500.10C Chapter 8 Quota Cancellation Policy. Personnel in receipt of orders to a Class "C" school have ten days from receipt of orders to cancel orders, request a substitution, or submit a waiver request. After ten days, the member must have Command approval to cancel or substitute the quota. Cancellation requests should be sent via message to the appropriate Program Manager or ETQC within ten days of receiving orders. Requests for cancellations will be considered by the Program Manager for the respective course. *Class convenings are entered into DA as we receive the Data sheets from the Course Lead Instructor

****Please note that for classes scheduled, If local students in those classes are approved by the POC, Districts must issue NO-COST orders. DA should identify how many funded Auxiliary C-school quotas are available for that session. You must check with the host DIRAUX and Lead Instructor to obtain a quota for those classes.
