ALAUX 17-14 - PASSWORD CHANGES FOR AUXLMS AND AUXDATA

- 1. The U.S. Coast Guard and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary take data security very seriously.
- 2. In order to maintain our high level of data integrity, the Auxiliary Learning Management System (AUXLMS [https://auxlearning.uscg.mil/) will institute a global password reset today, Thursday, 4 September 2014, during its scheduled maintenance window of 2000-2300 EDT.

3. For all AUXLMS users:

- a. Upon your next log-in, you will be prompted to change your password. The new password will need to be at least 14 characters long.
- b. As with the initial password, the new password will be entered using the "I forgot my password" link on the AUXLMS log-in page.
- c. The AUXLMS is the hosting site for the Auxiliary's online Mandated Training courses, VE Workshop and ICS-210 course, among other offerings. This requirement will affect any Auxiliarist who wishes to take these courses online.
- 4. A similar global password reset effort for all AUXDATA users (https://auxdata.uscg.gov/) is also already underway.
- 5. As always, the Auxiliary's National Help Desk [http://help.cgaux.org/] is prepared to assist any members experiencing issues with their password changes.
