

ALAUX 17-14 - PASSWORD CHANGES FOR AUXLMS AND AUXDATA

1. The U.S. Coast Guard and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary take data security very seriously.
2. In order to maintain our high level of data integrity, the Auxiliary Learning Management System (AUXLMS <https://auxlearning.uscg.mil/>) will institute a global password reset today, Thursday, 4 September 2014, during its scheduled maintenance window of 2000-2300 EDT.
3. For all AUXLMS users:
 - a. Upon your next log-in, you will be prompted to change your password. The new password will need to be at least 14 characters long.
 - b. As with the initial password, the new password will be entered using the "I forgot my password" link on the AUXLMS log-in page.
 - c. The AUXLMS is the hosting site for the Auxiliary's online Mandated Training courses, VE Workshop and ICS-210 course, among other offerings. This requirement will affect any Auxiliarist who wishes to take these courses online.
4. A similar global password reset effort for all AUXDATA users (<https://auxdata.uscg.gov/>) is also already underway.
5. As always, the Auxiliary's National Help Desk (<http://help.cgaux.org/>) is prepared to assist any members experiencing issues with their password changes.
