#### Overview for Division Staff Officers (SO-MS)



- SO-MS Appointment
- SO-MS Duties and Responsibilities
- SO-MS Training and Education
- Auxiliary Volunteer Support and Outreach

#### **Division Staff Officer (SO-MS)**



- Appointed by the Division Commander (DCDR) for a one year term
- Responsible for the Marine Safety program at the Division level
- Reports to the Vice Division Commander (VDCDR) and the DSO-MS (often through a regional ADSO)

NOTE: There are no Assistant Division Staff Officers for Marine Safety

#### **SO-MS** Duties and Responsibilities

- Manages the MS/MEP program within their Division and coordinates activities with flotillas
- Keeps DSO/ADSO informed of plans, missions, and activities
- Provides training opportunities for Flotilla Staff Officers for Marine Safety (FSO-MS)
- Delivers member training presentations to Division Board and staff
- Organizes Division-level MS/MEP activities and other duties as may be assigned by the DCDR
- Develops, encourages, and maintains Division-wide interest in MS/MEP missions



#### **SO-MS** Recommended Training

- Good Mate course
- IMSEP course
- Incident Command System Courses 100, 200, 210, 700 and 800
- MS/MEP qualifications found under MS on the Prevention website (MSAM highly recommended)
- Marine Safety Training Ribbon:
  - One MS/MEP qualification
  - Opportunity to learn the qualification process
  - Enables SO-MS to lead with full program experience
- Participation in MS/MEP activities and missions in their AOR

### **Auxiliary Volunteer Support and Outreach**



- Waterway cleanups
- Sea Partners
- External organizations and PA events
  - Local conservancy groups
  - Civic organizations
  - Yacht and paddlesport clubs
  - Schools, colleges and universities
- Marina visits
- Flotilla and Division PA events
