The Coast Guard Sector Commander is responsible for all Coast Guard missions within the sector's area of responsibility. Unless otherwise specified, the Sector Commander's authorities include Search and Rescue Mission Coordinator, Federal Maritime Security Coordinator, Federal On-Scene Coordinator, and, in most Sectors, Officer in Charge Marine Inspection (OCMI) and Captain of the Port (COTP). In his or her capacities as OCMI and COTP, the Sector Commander is responsible for a Marine Inspection Zone and COTP Zone.

The Captain of the Port offices operate within defined geographical areas of the United States, its territories, and possessions including portions of the high seas adjacent thereto. The description of the districts is established by the Commandant under the authority delegated by 33 CFR 3.01 to 3.85.
