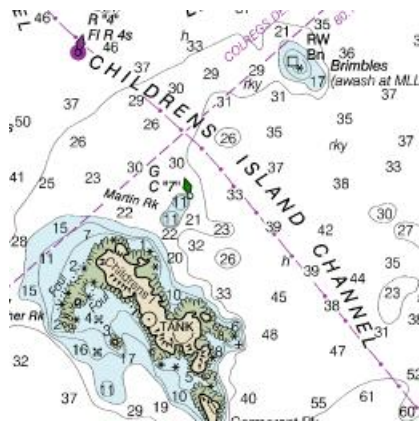


Day Markers Repairs

Fixed aids to navigation, called day markers, have not been maintained. Over the past few years, as I have previously discussed, several local day marks have been lost. Most will not be replaced as there are floating aids to navigation in their vicinity. It has not been determined if the Bowditch Ledge marker will be replaced.

During this past June, the day marker on the Brimbles, Light List Number 10405, was repaired. That should make it last for as long as most of us are still here.



As a matter of interest, the red dashed line is the high pressure, natural gas pipe line that runs from Weymouth to Salem. It is buried, but you should not anchor near it.

The Whaleback day beacon, off Manchester, Light List Number 9990, is also supposed to be rebuilt.
