

Isolated Hazzard Buoy

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An Isolated Danger Buoy is used to mark a specific hazard or obstruction such as a rock, shoal or sunken boat. The buoy is moored on or above the hazard, and will have navigable (safe) water all around it. Stay well clear of the buoy.

Hazzard buoys are black with one or more red stripes. If lit, the light is white. There will be two black balls atop the buoy.
