

If it is commonly used for navigation, Class 1 and 2, it will be shown in the Light List. <a href="https://www.navcen.uscg.gov/light-lists">https://www.navcen.uscg.gov/light-lists</a> If it is not used for navigation, it is Class 3.

The channel coming into Marblehead is an example of PATONs.



There are two Class 3 PATONs off the float at Crocker Park. These are swim zone buoys that are not on the Light List or on charts.
