Propane Tank Recertification

Per 49 CFR § 180.205, propane tanks, regardless of construction material, have to be recertified 12 years after original manufacture, and every 5 years after that. https://www.phmsa.dot.gov/sites/phmsa.dot.gov/files/docs/propane en v3.pdf. Since not all businesses that sell propane can do propane tank certification you will to need to find a propane company that specializes in propane. Note that excessively rusty or damaged tanks won't be recertified and you'll need to replace them.
