

Instructions to sew on tape and devices:

NAME tape immediately above the right chest pocket, USCG AUXILIARY tape immediately above the left pocket, each centered, and with the ends of the tape extending to the edge of the pocket. For attaching the embroidered collar devices. Make sure the anchors are properly oriented:
