• Call to order, Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence

Call to Order 1800.

USCG Station Menemsha Open House: Longval said it is the first open house for the station, his third with 24 years in the CG. Aux to take point on open house, "Two to three years down the road this will be an auxiliary event- it is my goal that the auxiliary really owns this."

Longval asked we highlight EPIRBs in addition to PFDs and recalled a case of 2 adults, 2 children in the water who were overflown by CG SAR aircraft at least 25 times over 18 hours before being rescued- "I think about that a lot, a \$200 EPIRB and they probably would have been found in a hour or two."

Dues and meeting survey results- Survey found most in favor of rate increase with 15 yes, 3 no and 4 unanswered. Dues approved as previously discussed.
