FC Comments:

- With 2020 forcing us to cease all programs and stop meeting in person, 2021 presents both a unique opportunity and challenge for the flotilla. My goals as Flotilla Commander for 2021 focus on returning us to fulfilling our primary mission of recreational boating safety, supporting Station Menemsha and getting underway with patrols through the following:
 - Begin teaching RBS courses, virtually until cleared to return to classrooms with classes starting in early Spring.
 - Work with local agency and town officials to coordinate RBS classes including class space, hosting online and advertising. Also work with town, county and state organizations to offer PVs, VSCs and outreach to the boating community.
 - A renewed focus on training and certification for boat crew.
 - Establish a AUXAIR committee to explore the formation of an AUXAIR component on Martha's Vineyard.
 - Work with Station Menemsha to provide renewed support and increased presence including but not limited to watchstanding and Food Service.
 - Recruitment of new members with an increased push to highlight the auxiliary to boating, sailing, environmental and community organizations and attract new members.
- V D-Train registration is open and this presents a huge training opportunity for members, especially since we do not have to travel for the classes. Everyone should take advantage of this opportunity- there are courses and classes for all areas of interest and it presents a great opportunity to meet other auxiliarists during the standdown.
- FSO-CS Berini is continuing to offer one-on-one AUXDATA2 tutoring sessions 1000 or 1500 daily by appointment. We are extremely fortunate that he is committed to getting us all up to

speed on the new system and I ask everyone please schedule a session and start using the new platform instead of 7029s by March

VFC Comments:

- We are still at a relaxed state as far as operations for the unit. I have spoken with Mrs. McClure (Aux Food Service Director) and restrictions are soon to be reduced for FS members. I also received the history on the Food Service program and it was confirmed Flotilla 11-9 was the 1st station to have a food service program. As restrictions get lifted I would like to see more members join the FS program and capitalize on the fact that we are the 1st in Food Service. That is a great honor that we should build and be strong at.
- COVID-19 Vaccine's are not being offered to CG AUX members at this time through the USCG. I tried to pull some strings to get us in early but Martha's Vineyard Hospital was getting ready to and now has started to vaccinate the public via the hospital patient health gateway. - Several live online training opportunities are still in progress. If you have Monday nights free that is when most classes take place. I have completed AuxOp Seamanship, Patrol Specialist, Weather Specialist, and are currently completing Communications and Boat Crew. All these classes have occurred over the past 3 months with one night a week online (plus some study and homework time). It can be done it is not much a commitment to take on. If you are interested in taking some additional online training classes it would be fantastic to have our flotilla come back strong and further educated into the station once restrictions are fully lifted.
