



INITIAL MANDATORY TRAININGS FOR NEW MEMBERS – 8.29.24

Congratulations on receiving your member id number, and thank you for joining the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and Flotilla 16-01! We're excited to welcome you and support you as you complete the initial mandatory trainings, and after that, getting engaged in some of the many volunteer service opportunities available.

As a new member, your first step is to complete the initial mandatory trainings and advance your status from AP (Application Pending) to BQ (Basically Qualified). This is the main activity during these early days of membership.

It involves completing a series of courses, all of which you can take online. This document provides a handy summary of what you need to do. The information will also help you to find the courses in the Auxiliary Online Classroom.

COURSE DETAILS

Here are your initial mandatory training requirements:

Auxiliary Core Training (AUX CT). AuxCT includes six courses and an open-book exam that we take as new members and renew every five years (Excepting Ethics/Personal Gifts, which is a one-time course). The courses are:

- ✓ Suicide Prevention
- ✓ Sexual Assault Prevention, Response, and Recovery
- ✓ Security Fundamentals
- ✓ Privacy at DHS: Protecting Personal Information
- ✓ Sexual Harassment Prevention
- ✓ Civil Rights Awareness

Ethics/Personal Gifts is a one-time video course that you view now and attest that you've watched it by signing and submitting a self-attestation form.

Basic Qualifications Course II (BQII). A one-time course that covers seven modules based on the Auxiliary Operations Manual with an open-book exam following each module.

Bloodborne Pathogens. A one-time course with open-book exam.

Introduction to Risk Management. This is an online video introduction to the Coast Guard's risk management processes. Every year, our Division provides mandatory refresher courses in-person and via teleconference.

Two FEMA Courses. These are required for Auxiliarists who want to serve in elected leader positions or get involved in operational roles. We strongly recommend that you take the two FEMA courses and complete the open-book exams now so that you don't have to take them later on.

- ✓ ICS 100 - Introduction to the Incident Command Management System
- ✓ ICS 700 - Introduction to the National Incident Management System

Boating Safety Course. Finally, you will need to submit documentation that you've completed a boating safety and seamanship (BS&S) course. If you haven't taken this course, our flotilla offers it or you can take it online. You can reach out to Robb Defilippis, our Flotilla Staff Officer, Public Education, for assistance in meeting this requirement. His email is robb11@gmail.com.

HOW TO ACCESS THE COURSES

AUXDATA II: The first step is to set-up your password in AuxData II, the Auxiliary's online data management tool. AuxData II is where we enter activity hours, manage and track flotilla and member training, access training, and more. You'll learn more about AuxData II through flotilla-based trainings. For now, set-up your password by clicking here:

You'll see a section at the top of the page entitled "To Access AuxData II." Click on the link provided and enter your user name. This is the employee id number that DIRAUX assigned you. Then, click on "Forgot Password" and follow the instructions to create your password.

AUXILIARY ONLINE CLASSROOM: Now that you have your AuxData II password, you can easily take all the courses in the Auxiliary Online Classroom. You can find this in the menu on the right side of the AuxData II homepage. See the *Quick Links* menu on the right side of the page and scroll down to the *Auxiliary Online Classroom*. Click here, see the blue box at the top of the page, and sign up for entry. (Step by Step Screen Shots are in the Appendix)

Once you're in the classroom, you'll see a page "Welcome to the Bridge. You Have the Helm." Click on the link in the center of the page to navigate to the *AUX Core Training Portal*. This takes you to the *AUX Core Training* page (be sure to click on the blue box to get the Enrollment Keys that you'll need to access the courses and **keep a record of these keys**). On this *AUX Core Training* page, you'll see the links for these required courses:

- ✓ AUX CT Core Certification Portal, where you can find all the required Core Training courses plus the two FEMA courses.
- ✓ Basic Qualification Course II – 2024
- ✓ Aux Blood Borne Pathogens

To get to the Introduction to Risk Management Course, go back to the “Welcome to the Bridge. You Have the Helm” page. Then look further down the page to see the *Directorate* pages heading and click on the link for Training and Leadership Development.

This takes you to the *Training Directorate Catalog*. Here, click on the *Risk Management and Operations Portal*, where you will find the Introduction to Risk Management Course.

Online Enrollment Keys for Self-paced Learning

Welcome to the Training Directorate Training Access Page

New enrollment security protocols have been implemented within the Auxiliary Classroom. These protocols require that every course have an extra layer of security at the course level.

Within the new AUX Classroom, there are 2 enrollment statuses.

1. **Manual Enrollment:** This is used for courses that have specialized enrollment criteria such as C-Schools or courses with limited enrollment. You will be enrolled directly by the course instructor.
2. **Self-Enrollment:** Any course open for self-enrollment now requires an **enrollment key**. Every directorate has a list of their unique enrollment keys for posts them protected behind the member zone log in.

Note: For security reasons please DO NOT copy/share these codes or post them on other websites.
