**Station Oak Island OIC Visit:** Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> Aug, along with Ann Marie Frazier (VFC) and Dawn Smith (USCG BMCM ret.) met with new Station Oak Island OIC – Senior Chief Josh Meyer. Significant discussion on interaction between Blue and Gold side mission support. Some highlights include:

- New SOI OIC (SC Meyer) much more receptive to symbiotic relationship between Blue and Gold side
- Stressed the need for SOI Watchstanders some training necessary, but integral to USCG
- Bayberry inport watch by Blue members still a good possibility
- Increase of Aux/USCG two-boat training evolutions. USCG members on AUX Facilities and Aux members on USCG platforms
- BMI Fuentes (ANT) highly desirous of AUX participation in ATON mission
- "First Light Response" day-time hours only, Cape Fear/ICW adjunct to USCG for SAR

## **Flotilla Staff Officer Highlights:**

**FSO\_OP:** Five Facilities were offered for sixteen patrols in the month of July. Six patrols were cancelled for shortage of coxswain/crew volunteers. Four patrols cancelled due to unfavorable weather. Six patrols were completed satisfactorily.

\*\* Out of a total flotilla membership of nearly 90 members, seventeen were active in operations during July for a **participation rate of 19%.** 

**FSO-VE:** 6 month stats for completed VEs do not stand up to previous year (2016). Ex. Goal for 2017 was to have 37 VSCs / VE, six-month stats show approximately 11 / examiner. July activity has been all but non-existent. Unusually hot weather may have played a role in the level of activity, but many opportunities were missed.
