 - a. None

 - **a.** Per tasking from DSO-IS Safranek, continuing to report percentage of 7029s submitted by active members. That percentage is very low across the flotillas reporting.
 - **b.** The security certificate for the AUXINFO website lapsed the first week of October, causing a warning notice flag for any members accessing the site. The certificate was renewed circa 11 October.
 - c. For Mac users, the most recent update to the operating system included an update to Safari. Safari version 12 no longer supports Java, which means Safari cannot be used to access AUXDATA. This is yet another browser that has ceased Java support. The only browsers that support Java are older versions of Firefox (v52 ESR), if an old version can be found, or Microsoft Internet Explorer, which is still available with Windows 10. No additional information has been made available by CGAUX IT regarding a replacement AUXDATA interface for the current Java based one
