I am pleased to report that Division 10's 2018 public education program is doing well. We are approaching last year's totals (SEE chart on next page) and there is every indication that we will meet or exceed that benchmark based on the remaining classes listed in the Auxiliary website (SEE schedule of completed classes and remaining classes below). As usual, most classes were ABS, however, we also taught 1 BSS class and 1 paddle board class this year. The following numbers on 2018 graduates listed below and on the chart were extracted from the AUX INFO data cubes.

10-01 (199 students to date) Two classes remain and are listed in the AUX Database: 7023 Intent To Teach Form. They will be taught on September 15 at Surf City, and September 16 at West Marine.

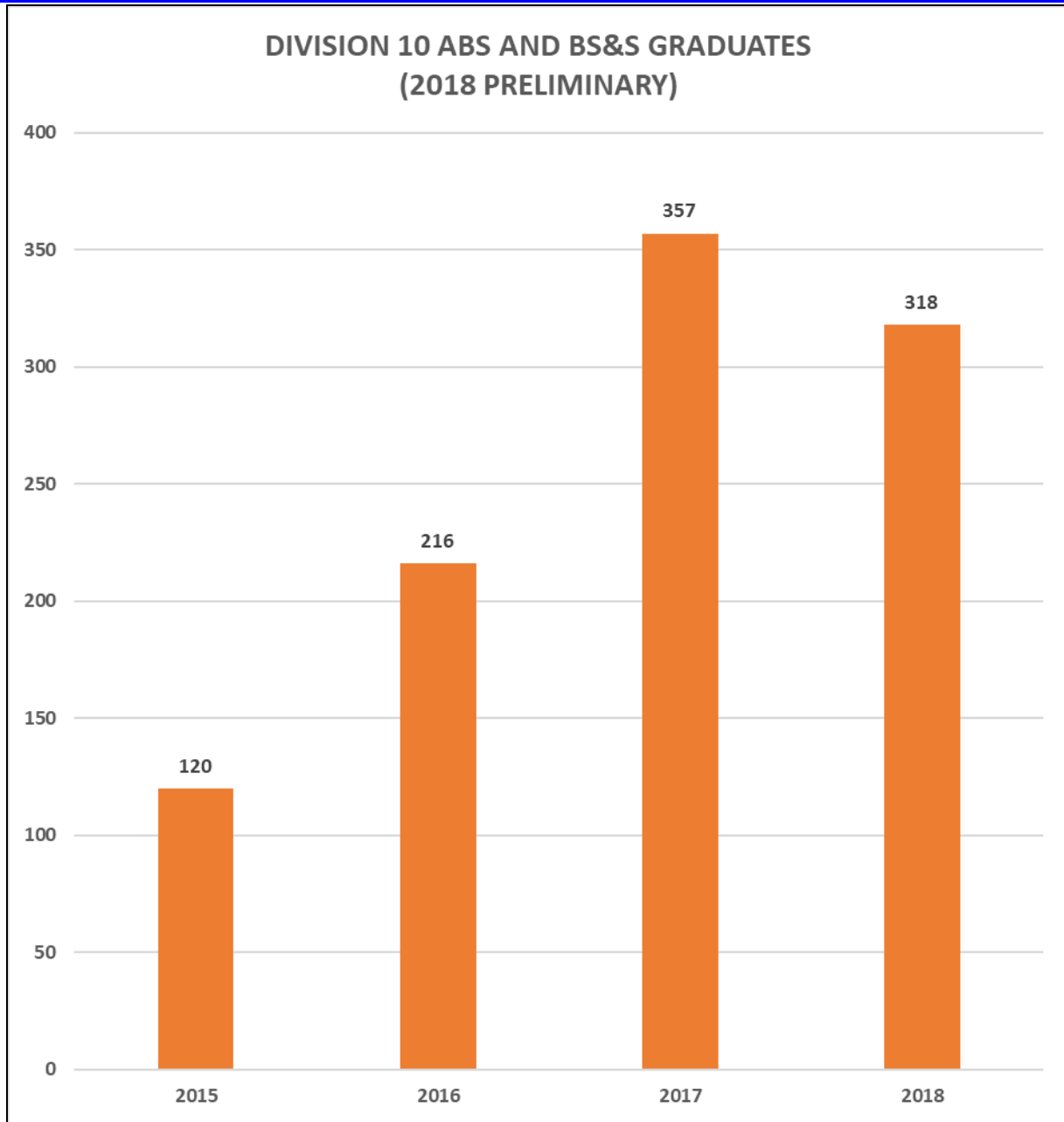
10-05 (108 students to date) Two classes remain and are listed in the 7023 Intent to Teach Form. They will be taught in Shallotte on August 18th and September 15.
