- 8. VE's should be aware that in a Marine Safety Alert 11-19, an Australian Producer of Type 1 PFD's has Recalled them due to improper Labeling of Buoyancy listings from 32 lbs. which should have stated only 22 LBS!!!
- 9. As of Nov 11, 2019, Division 10 has completed 299 VSC's on Power Boats and 235 VSC's on Paddleboards for a TOTAL of 543 which placed us in the # 11 in the District!!!
- 10. We can be off to a Great 2020 thru our New VE's as well as from our ABS classes as we also stress Marine Safety as well as thru Boat Dealers and Marina's!!!
