# a. 18/23: AUXILIARY COXSWAIN AND BOAT CREW INITIAL QUALIFICATION WAIVABLE TASK BY DIRECTOR (DIRAUX) POLICY LETTER RELEASED

- The Chief Director of Auxiliary signed CG-BSX Policy Letter 001-23, AUXILIARY COXSWAIN AND BOAT CREW INITIAL QUALIFICATION WAIVABLE TASK BY DIRECTOR (DIRAUX).
- ii. The purpose of this policy letter is to update the process of waiving tasks by the DIRAUX in the Auxiliary Boat Crew Qualification Handbook, ABQH 16794.52 (series).

## c. 20/23: NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK

i. Since 1958, the President has proclaimed the week prior to Memorial Day weekend as National Safe Boating Week (NSBW). Boating remains a highly popular, relatively safe, and memory-creating form of outdoor recreation. Preventing loss of life and damage is nonetheless a goal we all share, and we ask you to take precautions and encourage others to do so to make boating as safe as possible. The Office of Auxiliary and Boating Safety (CG-BSX) and the CG Auxiliary work extensively with the States and the recreational boating safety community on efforts to encourage model boating behavior. This year NSBW is from Saturday, May 20, 2023, through Friday May 26, 2023.

### a. 21/23: OPERATION DRY WATER

- ii. The purpose of this ALAUX is to provide notice of the 2023 Operation Dry Water (ODW) heightened awareness and enforcement weekend and to encourage maximum participation from Coast Guard units. This year, ODW will take place Saturday, July 1, 2023, through Monday, July 3, 2023.
- iii. Alcohol use continues to be the leading known contributing factor in recreational boating related deaths. ODW directly supports the National Recreational Boating Safety Program's efforts to eliminate alcohol and drug-related marine accidents and casualties. The Office of Auxiliary and Boating Safety's Boating Safety Division, (CG-BSX-2), in partnership with the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) and many other members of the boating safety community, will help coordinate this nationwide event.
