National Safe Boating Week

As National Boating Safety Week drew near, many Auxiliarists focused on Vessel Safety checks, boat crew, parades, and collaborations with West Marine for public outreach. As an educator and an Art



Teacher at Greenville Elementary in Fauquier County I had the unique opportunity to engage an entire school of students.

Wearing my life jacket to work sparked conservations not only with the students but also with

parents and staff during bus drop off and parent pick-up. The first question everyone asked was about the life jacket, which allowed me to discuss the significance of wearing them as summer approached.



The buzz continued as students walked into the art room where there was a display of various size and types of life jackets. The questions flew and the conversations started. I explained to them what the USCG did and I talked with each class about the importance to wear a life jacket. When asked how many wore a life jacket while on a vessel most said they did but there were quite a few who didn't. We discussed the law requiring them to wear one when out on the water and the different types for different purposes. Then I opened it up for discussion. The students were enthusiastic in sharing their experiences and asking numerous questions, such as: "What if I already know how to swim?" "Why are only 12 and under required to wear one?" "Why don't we need to wear one in a pool?" "Do I need to

wear one on a cruise ship?" Many shared stories of boating accidents, capsized boats and instances where life jackets had saved lives. These personal accounts were far more impactful than any lecture I could provide.



For the younger students (K-2nd grade) I read the "True Story of Inky the Whale" discussing the importance of keeping the waters clean and how they can help by picking up trash along the beaches and shores. They received an activity book and a coloring sheet illustrating how life jackets save lives. The older students (3rd -5th grade) were tasked with creating a stamp for NSBW/Life jacket saves lives and their creative solutions were impressive.

By the end of the week I had engaged with 22 different classes reaching over 500 students, staff and parents. Each class was ended with the statement "I look forward to hearing all about their fun and safe times on



the water this summer."
