Possible Situations

- Direct vs Indirect Pick-up

- **Direct:** Boat moves directly to PIW who cannot assist self (e.g. victim unconscious)
- **Indirect:** Victim is conscious, can receive, grasp a heaving line

In each case, PIW is brought alongside, either by moving the boat to the victim (direct) or pulling the victim to the boat (indirect)

- Only Coxswain and 1 Crew on board

- Coxswain secures engine and assists crew to get PIW onboard

Man Overboard : Initial Action

Crew

- First person (**Pointer**) to recognize MOB situation: "MAN OVERBOARD<ltbr>Port side/ /starboard/stern etc."
- Pointer maintain sight of PIW, move to location where coxswain can see you, continuously point (open-handed) to location of PIW
- Deploy datum

Coxswain

- Turn boat in direction indicated
- Sound emergency alarm (5 short blasts)
- Turn on safety light
- Inform COMM if time
- Order datum deployment
- Mark datum position

Coxswain may relieve pointer of duty when he has PIW in sight, so pointer shifts to recovery

MOB: Recovery Preparations

Coxswain

- Brief crew on duties/procedures
 - Direct / indirect recovery
 - Pick-up side
 - Pointer /recoveryman etc
- Proceed at safe speed to pick-up location

Crew:

- Receive briefing, move to assigned position
- Prepare heaving line, boat hook etc. as needed

Always loud and clear communications and parroting

MOB: Recovery

Coxswain

- Order to throw heaving line if indirect method
- When PIW alongside, engine in neutral
- If PIW drifts aft of boat do not back-down

Crew

- Throw heaving line if indirect method, bring PIW alongside
- Guide Coxswain to PIW
- Once PIW alongside, gain positive control of PIW
- Inform coxswain of control of PIW
- Pull PIW into boat using 2 persons
- Check ABC

Man Overboard: Follow-up

- Operational command advised of situation / status
 - COMM informs Order Issuing Authority (OIA)
- Render First Aid as needed
- Coxswain send SITREP to DIRAUX thru Chain of Leadership (CO

Note: PIW should be recovered within 5 minutes
