

Addendum “1” to Division 11 Standing Rules: Awards

Commencing for the calendar year 2010 and each calendar year thereafter, Division 11 Awards will be determined from applicable data extracted from AuxInfo or its successor and will be presented at the annual Division 11 Awards Banquet.

Individual Awards

Individual Awards in the following categories will be awarded to the members of each Flotilla who shall attain the prescribed minimum units in the calendar year:

FLOTILLA OPERATIONS >150 Hours

RBSPV(MDV) >75 Visits

INSTRUCTOR/AIDE (Public Education and Member Training) >50 Hrs
Non Lead Public Education Hours will be calculated at 50%

PUBLIC AFFAIRS OUTREACH >25 Hrs
Determined by utilizing RBS DEVICE
AWARD CRITERIA Sec 1.C Effective 22
January, 2010 or as later amended.

CG OPERATIONAL SUPPORT >250 Hrs

VESSEL SAFETY CHECKS >50 Exams

PLAQUES AND CERTIFICATES:

The individual in each Flotilla who attains the highest number of units in a specified category will be awarded a plaque for “outstanding performance” in the respective category. All other individuals who attain the minimum number of units in the category will receive a “certificate for meritorious performance.”

OUTSTANDING FLOTILLA:

A plaque will be awarded to the Flotilla which has the highest number of combined units attained during the calendar year in the following categories. Should a tie score exist, a tie breaker will be determined by selecting the Flotilla with the best score in one specific category as the winner. Selection of the tie breaking category will be made by the Division Commander. The “Outstanding Flotilla Plaque” will be retained for one year by the winning flotilla whereupon a permanent plaque will be awarded in lieu thereof.

The four (4) categories and their measurement criteria are:

1. Growth & Retention
Number of Members
Expressed as the percentage of net gain in membership for the calendar year where the membership number on January 1 is

the base.

2. Operations

Number of Patrol Hours

Determined by the total patrol hours performed by the top twenty (20) members in each flotilla that have performed 150 or more patrol hours.

3. Recreational Boating Safety

Determined by utilizing RBS DEVICE AWARD CRITERIA Effective 22 January, 2010 or as later amended.

(Includes PE, PA, VSC, PV, Legislative Outreach and State RBS Outreach.)

4. Member Training
