All Divisions are busy promoting and conducting PE classes and in trying to recruit Auxiliary members.

U.S Coast Guard Support:

<u>ADSO PA North:</u> Roy Crittenden reports that <u>Div. 2 (21)</u> represented the CG at the Ironman Triathlon with a vessel facility on the Savannah River to oversee the safety of 3,500 swimmers. <u>Div. 17 SO-PA Giers</u> is working with commercial fishermen to inform them of new mandatory vessel exam regulations.

1. Community Support North: Div. 2 (21) made a presentation to the Augusta Arts Council for the Ironman Event. (22) has contacted the Boy Scouts to conduct VSCs on their vessels in the local area. (25) FSO-PA Rudy will present patriotism classes to elementary and high school student and will wear his volunteer Army Veteran hat. Div. 12 (12-1) had a VE blitz and safety booth at Scarborough's Landing. (12-4) Members acted as judges in the South Atlantic Shrine Assoc. Annual Meeting at Myrtle Beach. (12-10) and (12-4) will work jointly at the Georgetown Wooden Boat Show. (12-1) members patrolled the "Three Stump Barge Party" in Potato Creek, Lake Marion. They continue to stencil safety signs at major boat ramps on Lake Marion. Div. 17 (17-11) gave appreciation certificates signed by CWO Perry to local donors for Coast Guard Day. They also are coordinating the toy drive (Annual, "Fill the Boat") for needy children in Orange and Osceola Counties. Special **Involvement: Div. 2 (25)** FSO PA Rudy submitted an article promoting Auxiliary membership to Country Roads Magazine and the Hartwell Lake News. ADSO PA Roy Crittenden had his monthly article on boating safety published in Lakeside on Lanier Newspaper. He promoted PE courses in 8 local newspapers and 3 radio stations. Div. 12 (12-1) has announcements for ABS in local papers on both sides of Lake Marion. (12-10) will have their new "Coastie" at the Georgetown Wooden Boat Show. (12-6) was awarded First Place in the Commodore's Cup Award and (29) was awarded Third Place. **Div. 17 (17-2)** is working with TV 13 to get a calendar of Aux events on air. They are also trying to obtain radio support. (17-6) has news releases and course offerings in local papers in Happenings in Port St. John, Florida Today and Hometown. SO PA Crittenden is coordinating Aux involvement for the 2013 Atlanta Boat Show.

- ADSO-PA South: Lourdes Oliveras reports that Div. 13 members continue to serve as radio watch-standers at Station Marathon, Station Islamorada and Key West on a regular basis.
