Condition Five (01 Dec -31 May) - Stand Down Review Flotilla Hurricane and Disaster Contingency Plan During January and February, planning liaison meetings with Flotilla's Coast Guard order issuing authority. Radio nets and drills should simulate field communications. Plan to Division Commander, SO-OP and FSO-OP before 28 Feb
Condition Four (1 Jun - 30 Nov)
<ul> <li>June - Conduct Heavy Weather Contingency training.</li> <li>June - Review with members all plans and requirements for Conditions 3,2, 1, and Post Storm Operations.</li> <li>Flotilla roster and calling tree be examined and amended as needed. Forward changes to division SO-OP.</li> <li>Auxiliarists should review the family evacuation/safe haven plans</li> <li>All vessels, mobile support units and generators should be maintained at 70% fuel capacity.</li> </ul>
Condition Three (Threatening winds - 50-knot sustained winds)
<ul> <li>Within Targeted Area</li> <li>FC, VFC and SO-OP ensure all contingency plans met for Conditions Four and</li> <li>Five All flotilla members should prepare for evacuation.</li> <li>Large vessels and trailered boats to their designated areas.</li> <li>Aircraft evacuated</li> <li>FC, VFC, FSO-OP contact DCP or VCP and advise Condition Three requirements are completed.</li> </ul>
Outside Targeted Area
<ul><li>All operational facilities 100% fueled and status reported to FC, VFC or FSO-OP</li><li>Towing vehicles fueled and ready</li></ul>

Ready to activate nets within 24-hour notice.

Watch stander schedules 24-hour watch for Condition two.

All operational facilities 100% fueled and status reported to FC, VFC or FSO-OP Towing vehicles fueled and ready  VHF-FM stations and long range HF-SSB should ensure readiness (batteries/power and conduct an exercise to verify communications and report to FC, VFC, FSO-OP. Ready to activate nets within 24-hour notice.  Watch stander schedules 24-hour watch for Condition two.
Condition Two (threatening winds within 24hours)
<ul> <li>Within Targeted Area</li> <li>All flotilla members should have secured their properties and evacuated.</li> <li>All Auxiliarists take working uniform and ID card.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Outside Targeted Area</li> <li>FC, VFC and FSO-OP check all requirements for the prior conditions are met.</li> <li>Flotilla VHF and long range HF-SSB nets are activated.</li> </ul>
Condition One (storm has come and departed)
<ul><li>■ Within Targeted Area</li><li>■ All flotilla members should have evacuated.</li></ul>
<ul> <li>Outside Targeted Area</li> <li>Flotillas ensure prior conditions have been met.</li> <li>Radio nets are active and reporting hourly.</li> <li>All Auxiliarists on alert and prepared to be deployed within 3 hours</li> </ul>
Condition Post Storm (storm has passed)
<ul> <li>Within Affected Area</li> <li>Responsibility of safety for family and property. Advise nearest order issuing authority when available</li> </ul>
Outside Affected Area Flotillas respond as called upon for support .
