- Update on requirements/procedure for VSC and RBS visits
 - 7001 Covid Form must be sent to DIRAUX, this will be done only one time unless you have updates that require a new form.
 - After your 7001 Form is sent in, contact the Division Commander Greg Little for Approval to do these functions. This is a one-time approval and does not need to be repeated each time you wish to do a VE or RBS visit.
 - You also need to notify a Flotilla staff officer (FC, VFC or any other staff officer) when you will be out on a detail, where, and when you are done. A phone call or text message would suffice.
- There will be an in-person D-Train (District Training) this year. D-Train will be in Dunkirk, NY, Sept. 18-19.
 - It will be held at the Clarion Hotel & Conference Center, on beautiful Lake Erie. More info will be released on reservations and class schedules soon.
