OLD BUSINESS:

- Russ stressed the importance of completing mandated training
 - Things you cannot do if mandated training not completed by end of year:
 - Cannot hold office
 - Cannot get an Auxiliary ID card once yours expires
 - Can not do VE's, PV's, Operations, or any other event besides fellowship events.
 - Cannot wear the Auxiliary Uniform
 - > Cannot buy items using your ID card
 - Cannot be marked as current in qualifications.
 - Things you can do:
 - Can vote in Auxiliary meetings.
 - Can attend meetings (as long as Auxiliary ID is not required)
 - Can attend fellowship events
 - Will have 100 and 700 FEMA classes will be given at Station Lorain on 11/12/16 but test must be done on line by computer. Bring your own laptop to the class if you have one. If you do not we will have some laptops available to be used.
 - Can get help taking the FEMA courses at Elyria library
 - For those classes mandated training classes that are not the FEMA classes, you
 can download the powerpoint, read it and sign paper saying you have gone
 through program. Contact Russ Cromwell or Greg Little for more details.
 - Russ Cromwell is willing to come to station to present needed classes to complete mandated training to those that would like to do the classes in the evening.
- Al Rosich expressed concerns about low finances in our flotilla last meeting.
 - Russ Cromwell FC agreed with Al and said that the flotilla has been surviving mostly from dues and donations from the members.
 - Russ said at the last Division meeting on September 7th he asked Division Commander Judith Stobinski to request District/National what examples they have for how to raise money besides boating classes.

- Suggested that money saved by members using Auxiliary discounts be donated back to flotilla

NEW BUSINESS:

• Commodore elect Scofield has asked me to enlist your help with the problem of unreachable members. Through our use of Everbridge we consistently find about 58 members who are unreachable by email. Everbridge defines "unreachable" as "no contact path is defined for the delivery methods used", in this case email only. As you know if a member does not have a valid email address he will be unable to actively participate as our programs or comply with mandated requirements. Our principal concern is that in an emergency or crisis situation we need to be able to find our members and to know that they are safe.
