District Board & Staff Reports:

DCDR 1 Diana Serchia – Report on file: 1st Division meeting was in Jan. Formed committees and passed budget.

DCDR 3 Dean McFarren—Report on file: Conducted PA event for Finest Hours which was a success. Had meeting at Station Rio Vista. Interactions with sector will be through Rio Vista.
