GET YOUR CA BOATER'S CARD TODAY!

All vessel operators operating a non-rental motorized vessel >14hp or a sailboat >29' and over the age of 18, MUST obtain a California Boater's Card by Jan 1, 2025

Boat America – 1 day – 8 hour class. Saturday, August 23 8:30am to 6:00pm

The class will cover what you need to know about operating a boat safely. Subjects include:

Rules, navigation, Coast Guard requirements, risk management, aids to navigation, registering your boat and many other subjects to help you be a better, safer boater

Anyone operating a motorized vessel in California waters must now have a Boater Operator card issued by the State of California. This class will meet the State requirement.
